2. Final Public Hearing on Budget and Taxes for FY 2020/2021

a. Announcement and discussion of tentative millage rate of 5.5600 per \$1,000 of taxable value and the percent of increase (17.8%) over the rolled-back rate (4.7195). The increase over last year's actual millage rate (14.64%).

b. Presentation of tentative Budget for FY 2020/2021

c. Public Comments: Tracy Siani commented on the length of time it takes to prepare a budget, and thanked Chip Block especially for his work on the budget. Mayor Comerford also thanked Gasper Taormina for his volunteer work preparing the budget.

d. Vote: Adoption of Resolution No. 2020 - 07 of the Town Commission of the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida, establishing and levying the final millage rate of 5.5600 mils per \$1,000 of taxable value for the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida's ensuing Fiscal Year 2020/2021.

Vice Mayor Chip Block made a motion to accept Resolution 2020-07. Commissioner Keim seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

e. Vote: Adoption of Resolution No. 2020 - 08 of the Town Commission of the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida, Approving the Estimates of Revenue and Expense for the Fiscal Year Commencing on the 1st Day of October 2020 and Ending on the 30th Day of September 2021 (Annual Budget).

Vice Mayor Chip Block made a motion to approve Resolution 2020-08. Commissioner Armato seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.
