## **MASS READING REFLECTION**

November 22, 2020

1st Reading EZ 34:11-12, 15-17 King of the Universe

**Both the First Reading and the Gospel** describe Jesus as king, using the imagery of shepherd and flock. There is a German saying: "He who wants to understand the poet must go to the poet's country." Shepherds and sheep were part of daily life in the country of the Bible, Mentally, we should go there whenever we read Scripture and want to understand what God has to tell us through the author. God in his Messiah (Anointed King Jesus Christ) takes care of us.

The last verse with its note about judgement links this reading with the Gospel, where the king separates the sheep from the goats. "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want" (Responsorial Psalm).

## 2nd Reading 1 Cor 15:20-26,28 [Christ the Firstfruits]

Paul teaches that Jesus' reign as king, inaugurated with his resurrection, will last until his second coming. Then he will hand over the kingdom to the Father.

The meaning is that God now acts towards the world "through Jesus Christ, our Lord." At the end of time, God's relationship with redeemed mankind will be a direct one. Meanwhile notice that Jesus' kingdom is in constant warfare with evil. "[Christ] must reign until [God] has put all his enemies [evil] under his feet." We should be part of that warfare against evil! In our democratic culture, we know about kings and emperors only from television and picture magazines. But we believe in leaders, "deriving (though) their just powers from the consent of the governed" (Declaration of Independence). Enlightened and reliable leadership is a great benefit to any society. We expect our leaders to be conscientious people, responsible to God, since we are "one nation under God." Our leaders must be equally concerned about all, since "all men are created equal."

If we had to describe what Jesus Christ means to Christians, we would most probably do so with this familiar terminology of the founding fathers. Hence, we should not be amazed that the Bible describes Jesus as a king, since leaders and kings were identical in Biblical culture. The Hebrews knew about the splendor of King Solomon, the heroic dedication and courage of their "founding father," King David, and the might and power of the kings of Egypt and Babylon; hence, they used these familiar images to describe Jesus' relationship to the people he consecrated "by his own blood" (Heb 13:12).

Leadership is an alternative to a warped kind of freedom, which results in chaos and disaster. We experience it daily around us. Let us submit to Jesus' leadership.

## Moving to Orange

Dear Valued Community Members,

Conejos County has reached a point in the progression COVID-19 pandemic where we are unable to keep the virus manageable with the guidelines we have had in place over the past few months. We were moved from Yellow to Orange on the State's COVID Dial as of Saturday. November 14. at 5pm.

It is important to do all we can to keep our schools, our places of worship, and our businesses open to the greatest extent possible while protecting the vulnerable among us, and doing our best to avoid overwhelming our clinics and hospitals. If we can pull together to bring down COVID-19 in our community, we can weather these winter months and move a step closer to having a vaccine.

Houses of worship and Life Rites may operate at 25% of the posted occupancy limit indoors not to exceed 50 people excluding staff, whichever is less, per room, calculated using the Distancing Space Calculator. For seated events, the usable space may be calculated using 6 feet distancing between nonhousehold contacts instead of using the calculator. Outdoor worship services shall operate at the same level as Blue.
