Texas A&M upset No. 1 Alabama 41-38 as 18.5-point underdogs last Saturday night. The Aggies were more than 7/1 on the money-line! The Crimson Tide had incredibly won 100 straight games vs unranked opponents dating back to 2007.

### ATS Notables

Ball St was +38 ATS points at Western Michigan in a 45-20 win (+13).  
Akron was +29 ATS points at Bowling Green in a 35-20 win (+14).  
The Oklahoma/Texas game went OVER the total by 37.5 points.  
The Arkansas/Ole Miss game went OVER the total by 36.5 points.  
Georgia is 5-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 14.7 ppg!  
Clemson is 0-5 ATS this year failing to cover the spread by 12.2 ppg!  
Missouri has failed to cover the spread in 9 straight games by an average of 11.6 ppg.  
The OVER is 5-0 in Pitt games going OVER by an average of 18.8 ppg!  
The UNDER is 5-0 in Purdue games going UNDER by an average of 17.7 ppg!

### Misleading Finals

Charlotte beat FIU 45-33. However, FIU had a 538-378 yard edge. FIU got stopped on downs at the Charlotte 3-yard line and also threw a "Pick 6".

Wake Forest beat Syracuse 40-37 in OT. However, Syracuse had a 514-426 yard edge including 354-96 on the ground. The Orange held a 21-10 lead with 6:49 to go in the second quarter, but a decision to accept a holding penalty on third down when declining would have set up a 51-yard field goal attempt by Sciba seemed to turn the momentum. Wake converted on third-and-23 and scored a touchdown to trim the halftime lead to 21-17, the first of 16 straight points. The Orange opted to kick a field goal on fourth-and-2 from the Wake Forest 27 midway through the fourth quarter and Szymt missed from 45 yards.

Ball St upset Western Michigan 45-20. However, WMU had a 376-275 yard edge but were -4 in TO's. Ball St out-scored WMU 21-0 in the 4Q.

Boise St upset BYU 26-17. However, BYU had a 413-312 yard edge but were -4 in TO's. The Cougars repeatedly failing to convert in the red zone in the second half. Katoa's second fumble stopped one drive at the Broncos 13. An incomplete fourth-down pass from Hall stopped a second drive at the Boise State 5.

UAB beat FAU 31-14. However, UAB only had a 306-291 yard edge. With FAU driving down 17-14 late 2Q, UAB got a 100-yard interception return TD.

Florida beat Vanderbilt 42-0. However, the shutout was misleading as Vandy missed 3 FG's (all <41 yards) and were stopped on downs at the Florida 1-yard line.

Tulsa beat Memphis 35-29. However, Memphis had a 614-417 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. Memphis missed 3 FG's.

### Bad Beats

Louisville (-2.5) led Virginia 30-13 entering the 4Q. At that moment, the betting site FanDuel offered -5000 in-game odds on the host team, implying the Cardinals had a better than 98 percent of winning. However, UVA got a 1-yard touchdown pass to with 22 seconds left to win 34-33. On that final drive, UVA completed passes of 17 yards on a fourth-and-6 and 16 yards on a fourth-and-8.

Nevada (-28.5) led New Mexico St 52-7 entering the 4Q but got back-doored with :08 left to only win 55-28.

Georgia QB JT Daniels (back) is questionable vs Kentucky.

Hawaii QB Chevan Cordeiro (shoulder) is questionable vs Nevada.

Indiana QB Michael Penix (shoulder) is out this week vs Michigan St. Jack Tuttle has been named the starter.

LSU WR Kayshon Boutte (ankle) is out for the season.

LSU DE Ali Gaye is out vs Florida this week.

Miami, FL QB D'Eriq King (shoulder) is out for the season.

Miami, OH QB Brett Gabbert is questionable vs Akron.

Minnesota RB Treyton Potts is out for the season. The Gophers will be down to a 3rd string RB with Mohamed Ibrahim already lost for the year.

New Mexico QB Terry Wilson (elbow) is questionable vs Colorado St.

Northern Illinois RB Harrison Waylee is questionable vs Bowling Green.

Oregon RB CJ Verdell (leg) is out for the season.

San Jose St QB Nick Starkel (arm) is questionable vs San Diego St.

According to head coach Gary Patterson, TCU QB Max Duggan and RB Zach Evans are questionable vs Oklahoma. We think both will play.

Texas WR Jordan Whittington (collarbone) is out indefinitely.

Utah St QB Logan Bonner (knee) has been upgraded to probable vs UNLV.

### Recapping Week 6 Best Bets

Our College Best Bets went 3-2. We easily won both of our top plays with UTSA/WKU going over the total early in the second half and Colorado St dominating San Jose St from start to finish. We also won outright with Akron (+14.5). It could have been a great Saturday but Troy (-5.5) blew a 24-3 3Q lead to only win by 3. Also the SMU/Navy game fell short by a 0.5-point! The two teams combined for 42 first half points and all we needed was two TD's in the entire second half. Nope! We went 2-2 in the NFL. **Games in Rotation Order**  
**Thursday, October 14th**

**SOUTH ALABAMA 26 Georgia Southern 25.** How does SA respond on a short week after a 4OT loss to Texas St? Meanwhile, GS rallied from a 24-3 deficit vs Troy last week to sink us on these pages (GS covered as 5.5-point underdogs in a 27-24 loss). That's 3 straight covers for them. Statistically, SA is the superior team at +0.2 ypp (No. 74) while GS is -1.4 ypp (No. 116). However, GS has played the tougher schedule. We're passing.

**MEMPHIS 35 Navy 24.** Navy has covered 3 straight games but last week we lost on the OVER in their game vs SMU by a 0.5-point! We thought we were in good shape at halftime with the score tied at 21-21. Nope! Meanwhile, Memphis has failed to cover in 3 straight games. Memphis is +1.1 in yards per play margin (No. 37) while Navy is -1.5 ypp (No. 118). However, Navy has played the tougher schedule. Early week money has come in on both the OVER and Memphis. We prefer the OVER at the current numbers.

**Friday, October 15th**

**Clemson 31 SYRACUSE 15.** Clemson comes in fresh off the bye and it will be interesting to see how they fare down the stretch. The Tigers have been miserable so far this year at 0-5 ATS failing to cover the spread by 12 ppg! Meanwhile, Syracuse is on a short week off an OT loss to Wake Forest. The Orange are 5-1 ATS this year covering by 7.6 ppg. The Orange are also an impressive +1.3 in ypp margin (No. 31). Still, our numbers lean with Clemson and we like the Tigers rest advantage. It is note-worthy that the Westgate Superbook listed Clemson as a 30.5-point favorite in this match-up during the summer!

**Marshall 36 NORTH TEXAS 27.** We just haven't been that impressed with Marshall this year. They are 0-4 ATS as a double-digit favorite failing to cover by 13.5 ppg. That includes a 20-13 OT win over ODU last week where the Herd were 21-point favorites! However, the "wise guys" keep betting them because their stats are great at +1.85 ypp (No. 14). Meanwhile, North Texas gave Missouri all they could handle last week in a cover. We lean dog and UNDER.

**San Diego St 26 SAN JOSE ST 19.** Two teams heading in opposite directions. The Aztecs are 5-0 straight up and have covered 4 straight games. Meanwhile, San Jose St has failed to cover in 5 straight games. That includes last week in a 32-14 loss at Colorado St (+3.5) where we easily cashed fading them on these pages. QB Nick Starkel remains questionable here. With that being said, we're not fond of laying more than a TD on the road especially with a low total.

**OREGON 35 California 20.** Both teams come in off a bye. Outside of the super impressive win at Ohio St, we haven't been impressed with the Ducks. They are 0-4 ATS in their other games which includes a ridiculous upset loss at Stanford in their last game. All-American DE Thibodeaux will have to sit out the first half of this game. Meanwhile, Cal has also disappointed at 1-4 straight up and losing outright as a home favorite twice already. We're not involved.

**Saturday, October 16th**

**2★ NORTHERN ILLINOIS 31 Bowling Green 17.** Last week we cashed on these pages fading Bowling Green as they lost outright to Akron as 2-TD favorites! We thought you were paying a premium on BG who at the time was the only 5-0 ATS team in the country. We still think there is value fading them this week. Northern Illinois has covered 3 straight and are averaging 225 rushing ypg. Meanwhile, BG is one-dimensional on offense averaging 57 rushing ypg.

**NORTH CAROLINA 37 Miami, FL 26.** North Carolina's "Jekyll and Hyde" season continued last week with another outright upset loss. This time to Florida St 35-25 as 17.5-point favorites. The Tar Heels have been favored in all 6 games by an average of 15 ppg but stand 3-3 straight up on the season. Can you say underachieving? Their opponent knows a thing or two about underachieving as the Hurricanes enter 2-3 SU going 0-4 ATS vs FBS team failing to cover by 12.6 ppg. QB D'Eriq King is out for the year and Tyler Van Dyke will be your starter. The Tar Heels destroyed Miami last year piling up 778 yards of offense. We think we see good North Carolina this week.

**Pittsburgh 31 VIRGINIA TECH 28.** Pitt comes in off a bye. Statistically, the Panthers are very impressive as they boast the No. 1 scoring offense in the country at 52.4 ppg. They are +216 ypg (No. 3), +29.8 ppg (No. 3) and +1.99 in yards per play margin (No. 13). Pitt QB Kenny Pickett has a 19-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio! The Panthers are taking on a VT fresh off blowing an 8-point lead vs Notre Dame in the final minutes last week. The Hokies are -0.34 in ypp (No. 96) and coach Fuente is on the hot seat. We bet Pitt at "Pick" on the Sunday openers and also the OVER which is 5-0 in Pitt games this year going OVER by 19 ppg! Pitt has lost too much value but we still lean OVER.

**Texas Tech 42 KANSAS 23.** Kansas comes in off a bye. Even with a new head coach it's still the same old Jayhawks at 0-4-1 ATS failing to cover by 10 ppg! Kansas has been outscored by 26.6 ppg, dead last in the country. Meanwhile, they're catching a Texas Tech team that should be plenty angry after getting blown out by TCU last week. The Red Raiders are +1.23 in yards per play (No. 33) and have alternated ATS wins/losses all year. They get the cover here.

**HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

**Michigan St 27 INDIANA 24.** Indiana comes in off the bye. The Hoosiers have been a big disappointment this season and have gone 0-4 ATS vs FBS teams failing to cover by 13.4 ppg. QB Michael Penix is out for this game and Jack Tuttle will get the start. We don't think it's that big of a downgrade considering Penix is completing only 54% of his passes with a 4-7 ratio. Meanwhile, Michigan St has vastly over-achieved so far this season already topping their season win total. The Spartans have a ton of play-makers led by RB Walker who already has 903 rushing yards and is averaging 7.1 yards per carry. WR's Jayden Reed and Jalen Nailor are both averaging more than 21 yards per catch! It's a big reason why MSU is +2.36 in yards per play margin (No. 9). With that being said, we think you're starting to pay a premium on them here. Amazingly, Indiana was a 16.5-point favorite at Draft Kings in this match-up during the summer! We lean Hoosiers and UNDER.

**WISCONSIN 28 Army 13.** It's very tough to lay two touchdowns with a total sitting at 39! However, Wisconsin was in a similar spot last week at Illinois and won 24-0 (-12.5). For the 5th straight time this season, the box score said Wisconsin should have performed better than the scoreboard as the Badgers had a 491-93 yard edge! The Badgers are +162.6 ypg (No. 10) but have been out-scored on the season! A turnover margin of -11 is the culprit. Meanwhile, Army comes in off a bye after suffering their first loss of the season. There's a huge disparity in strength of schedule as Wisconsin has played one of the toughest in the country while Army has yet to play a team in the Top 80 of our power ratings. We bet Wisconsin -10 on the Sunday openers.

**BUFFALO 31 Ohio 23.** At the conclusion of spring practice, these two were the favorites to win the MAC East Division this year. However, both lost their head coaches and both have struggled this season so far. After a brutal 0-4 ATS start, Ohio has covered in back-to-back games. Buffalo is -0.7 in yards per play margin (No. 106) but has played the tougher schedule. We lean UNDER.

**2★ UNDER 51 SOUTH CAROLINA 30 Vanderbilt 14.** How bad is Vanderbilt that the Commodores are getting nearly 3 TD's vs the 2nd worst team in the SEC? Vandy is 1-5 ATS failing to cover by an average of 13 ppg! The Dores are -2.44 in yards per play margin (No. 128) and we've never had a SEC team power-rated lower. Still, we bet numbers and we're not laying this kind of number with a South Carolina offense averaging just 22 ppg. We like Vandy and the UNDER here.

**Tulsa 32 SOUTH FLORIDA 23.** Tulsa comes in off a win over Memphis as they can't afford too many more slip-ups if they want to make a bowl game. Meanwhile, USF is off a bye. The Bulls have played a tough schedule but are -162 ypg (No. 125), -15.6 ppg (No. 121) and -2.26 yards per play (No. 125). Our numbers are close to the line. Please note that while Tulsa games are 5-1 to the OVER, it is -0.5 ppg to the OVER...margin matters.

**NC State 27 BOSTON COLLEGE 25.** Both teams come in off a bye. Both are 4-1 and are already positioning themselves to make a run at the ACC Championship game with Clemson down this year. BC is +0.93 in yards per play margin (No. 42). Meanwhile, NC State is +1.06 in ypp margin (No. 39). So why is NC State favored on the road? The Wolf Pack have compiled those stats against a tougher schedule. We make 30-40 bets each Sunday morning. We didn't bet either side or total in this one.

**Nebraska 25 MINNESOTA 22.** Even though their 3-4 record doesn't show it, Nebraska is a much improved team. They are +150 ypg (No. 11) and +1.74 in yards per play (No. 15). We have the Huskers No. 21 in our power ratings. Sooner or later, they have to start winning some close games as last week's 3-point loss to Michigan dropped them to 5-16 SU in games decided by 8-points or less since Frost took over in 2018. Most of those losses were the result of self-inflicted wounds in the form of turnovers and it happened again Saturday night. They're taking on a Minnesota team fresh off a bye (Nebraska is playing an 8th straight week!). We bet UNDER 50.5 on the Sunday openers and have a slight lean that way now.

**MIAMI, OH 36 Akron 17.** Last week we cashed on these pages with the Zips as they pulled the outright upset over Bowling Green as 2-TD underdogs. Do we go right back to them here? The answer is no as the Zips are still a bottom 10 team in the country. They are -2.23 in yards per play (No. 124). Meanwhile, Miami comes in off a 1-point loss to Eastern Michigan where the Red Hawks settled for 5 FG's (made 4 of them). Early week money came in on the Zips but we lean OVER.

**CINCINNATI 39 Central Florida 19.** Call us crazy but we actually came away more impressed with Cincinnati last week in their 52-3 win vs Temple than their win at Notre Dame a week earlier. The Bearcats, on a short-week after one of the biggest wins in school history, handled their business very well as huge favorites. Cincy is No. 4 in the country in yards per play margin (+2.84) and we have them power-rated as a Top 10 team. They'll be looking for style points from this point forward and they're capable of getting them vs a UCF team that has really struggled the last two weeks without QB Dillon Gabriel. Cincy is 4-0 ATS vs FBS teams (+12.4 ppg) while UCF is 0-4 ATS vs FBS teams (-10 ppg). That's why we laid -16 on the opener.

**VIRGINIA 38 Duke 26.** Lady luck has been on Virginia's side each of the last two weeks. Last week they trailed Louisville 30-13 entering the 4Q. At that moment, the betting site FanDuel offered -5000 in-game odds on Louisville, implying the Cardinals had a better than 98 percent of winning. However, UVA got a 1-yard touchdown pass to win 22 seconds left to win 34-33. On that final drive, UVA completed passes of 17 yards on a fourth-and-6 and 16 yards on a fourth-and-8. They're taking on a Duke team that hasn't been as fortunate with two close losses already this season. Virginia has won and covered 6 straight in this series but all of those favorite roles were by less than 7. Lean UNDER.

**Rutgers 23 NORTHWESTERN 21.** Northwestern comes in off a bye. The Wildcats are just 1-4 ATS this year and are -1.07 in yards per play margin (No. 111). They're taking on a Rutgers team playing a 7th straight week and coming off 3 straight losses to Michigan, Ohio St and Michigan St who are a combined 17-1. The Scarlet Knights are also -1.07 in ypp but have played the much tougher schedule. We bet UNDER 48.5 on the Sunday openers and still have a slight lean that way.

**Ball St 29 EASTERN MICHIGAN 26.** The Cardinals have officially turned their season around after back-to-back outright upset wins as double-digit underdogs. Last week they covered the spread by 38 points in their 45-20 win (+13) at Western Michigan. It was misleading (see page 1). Meanwhile, EMU got a 1-point win over Miami. Neither team has great stats as both have been out-gained and have negative ypp's. We don't see much value here.

**Colorado St 28 NEW MEXICO 15.** Last week on these pages Colorado St was our top side of the week and they delivered with a 32-14 win over San Jose St. That's 3 straight covers for the Rams by an average of 19.5 ppg! New Mexico is on the other side of the ledger at 0-6 ATS this season and failing to cover by 10.1 ppg! Their starting QB Terry Wilson is questionable here after injuring his elbow last week. We MAX bet Colorado St -7 on the Sunday morning openers, gave them out Sunday evening at -9.5 to VIP clients and still lean that way even at -10.5! We also lean UNDER.

**COLORADO 26 Arizona 18.** Colorado comes in off a bye. The Buffs offense is one of the worst in CFB averaging 240 ypg (No. 129) and 13.8 ppg (No. 129). Colorado is -1.8 in ypp margin (No. 121) and have failed to cover their last 3 games by an average of 18.2 ppg. They're taking on an Arizona team that has remarkably lost 17 straight games. The Wildcats also lost their QB Jordan McCloud for the season and Gunner Cruz will get the start here. We're not fond of laying points with a crappy offense but our numbers like CU here.

**BOISE ST 29 Air Force 23.** Boise St pulled off their first road win over a Top 10 team in 20 years last week vs BYU. It was a misleading game as Boise was +4 in TO's (see page 1). The Broncos are -0.74 in ypp margin (No. 107) but have played a much tougher schedule than the Falcons who come in at 5-1. This is the first time Air Force has been an underdog this year. Boise St has won and covered 4 straight in the series and our numbers like them again here.

**UTAH 25 Arizona St 24.** Last week was the first game for the Utes since safety Aaron Lowe was killed in a shooting at a post-game party on Sept. 26, nine months after running back Ty Jordan died of an accidental gunshot wound to the abdomen on Christmas night 2020. Utah won a road game against USC for the first time since 1916, which predates the opening of the Coliseum in 1923. This should be another emotional game for them and despite their stunning non-conference losses to BYU and San Diego St, the Utes still have everything to play for in Pac-12 play. They are +1.34 in ypp margin (No. 29). They're taking on an Arizona St team that is +2.4 in ypp margin (No. 7). The Sun Devils have rebounded from their loss to BYU to win and cover 3 straight. Lean Utah.

**Fresno St 31 WYOMING 25.** Fresno St comes in off a bye. They had one of the more misleading games in the entire 2021 season in their last game as they were upset by Hawaii. The Bulldogs were -5 in TO's including QB Jake Haener throwing 3 interceptions inside Hawaii's 10-yard line! We think that creates some value here vs a Wyoming team off their first loss of the season. The Bulldogs are +1.99 in ypp margin (No. 12 in the country).

**WASHINGTON 28 UCLA 27.** Washington comes in off a much-needed bye as the Huskies are one of the most disappointing teams in CFB so far this season. In the summer, some were calling for Washington as a dark-horse CFB Playoff contender but now they're sitting at 2-3 and 2nd-year coach Jimmy Lake's seat is starting to warm. They're taking on a UCLA team that is 4-2 but probably feels like they should be 5-1 or better considering they lost outright as a home favorite twice this season. Our ratings say this is a true coin-flip.

**LIBERTY 42 UL-Monroe 11.** Liberty sits at 5-1 SU and 5-1 ATS on the season with an average cover of 6.2 ppg. The Flames have gone 5-0 ATS in their last 5 games laying 3 TD's or more so they are capable of laying the lumber here. Meanwhile, ULM has been destroyed in their last two games. Despite notching 2 straight up wins this season, the Warhawks are dead last at -228 ypg and also dead last at -2.96 in ypp margin. Liberty is No. 7 in ypg (+178.6) and No. 10 in ypp margin (+2.31). That's why we're not betting the huge home dog. We do lean UNDER.

**BAYLOR 28 Byu 23.** Baylor is one of the most improved teams in the country. The Bears are 5-1 and off a blowout win over West Virginia. BU is No. 6 in the country in ypp margin (+2.6). BYU also comes in at 5-1 but the Cougars are coming off their first loss of the season. It was misleading as they were -4 in TO's vs Boise St. Early money has come in on Baylor here but we don't see too much value at the current numbers.

**Texas A&M 33 MISSOURI 24.** As soon as Texas A&M pulled off the shocking upset over No. 1 Alabama, we immediately wanted to play against them this week. We checked the schedule and...oh no, the Aggies are playing Missouri, the one team we just can't back right now. Why? Missouri has failed to cover 9 straight games dating back to last year. Their defense flat out stinks as they're allowing 38 ppg, 498 ypg and 287 rushing ypg. Even if Texas A&M is flat...they can still have success vs that Missouri defense that allowed 35 points and 493 yards last week to a feeble North Texas offense. On top of it, we're a little surprised Texas A&M is laying single-digits here as our power ratings on page 6 actually like A&M. We're passing.

**TEXAS 32 Oklahoma St 25.** The situation favors Oklahoma St here who come in off a bye. The Cowboys are a perfect 5-0 straight up on the season but haven't had overly impressive stats as they are +0.54 in ypp margin (No. 58). They arguably had their best performance in their last game, a 24-14 win

over a Baylor team that only has that one loss. Meanwhile, Texas comes in off a heart-breaking loss to Oklahoma. It was the first time in school history Texas lost a game while leading by 21 points or more and it will be interesting to see how they respond especially playing a 7th straight week. We wanted to play Oklahoma St here but that situational advantage looks like it is really baked into the number (see our power ratings on page 6). We actually lean Texas.

**OKLAHOMA 39 Tcu 26.** If you want to back Oklahoma here, there is definitely some concern that the Sooners left it all on the field last week in their dramatic come-from-behind win over Texas. It was arguably the game of the year in college football so far (if you like offense). Five of their six games have been decided by 7 points or less so it is tough laying double-digits here. However, the Sooners could take off with Caleb Williams at QB because we thought Spencer Rattler was overrated and didn't bother betting Rattler in the Heisman futures. Meanwhile, TCU is off their best performance of the season, a blowout win over Texas Tech. It was their first cover of the season. The early week money was on TCU until head coach Gary Patterson announced QB Max Dugan and RB Zach Evans are questionable. We think both will play. We're passing.

**Toledo 28 CENTRAL MICHIGAN 24.** Toledo OVER 7.5 wins was our favorite season win total bet of the season. Safe to say, that's taken a major hit with the Rockets losing 2 games outright as a 2-TD favorite already this season. They still have really good stats including +1.64 in ypp margin (No. 18) and the professional money has been on them in this match-up so far. Central Michigan also comes in at 3-3 but the Chips have failed to cover in 4 straight games and are -0.43 in ypp margin (No. 98). We're passing.

**Uab 30 SOUTHERN MISS 13.** UAB had a misleading 31-14 win over FAU last week. That included a 100-yard "Pick 6" right before halftime that completely changed momentum. The Blazers are playing with a backup QB in Dylan Hopkins but he has plenty of experience and has a 9-to-2 TD-to-INT ratio so far. Meanwhile, Southern Miss is down to a 3rd string QB in Jake Lange (3-4 ratio). The Golden Eagles are 1-5 ATS and -1.52 in ypp margin (No. 119). We lean UAB here. Totals players note that the two teams are a combined 10-2 to the UNDER this year. We bet UAB -14 on the Sunday openers.

**IOWA 27 Purdue 14.** We really want to fade this Iowa team. They're off one of their biggest wins in recent memory taking down Penn St 23-20 in a battle of Top 5 teams (at least in the AP Poll). The Hawkeyes were trailing 17-3 when Penn St's starting QB went out with injury. Iowa is only No. 53 in ypp margin but are No. 1 in the country in turnover margin at +15. They are playing a 7th straight week while their opponent Purdue comes in fresh off a bye. The Boilers need to fix an offense that has scored exactly 13 points in 3 straight games and we're not sure Iowa's defense is the game where it turns around. We wanted "14" to be in the market place. It's not there so we're passing.

**3★ Alabama 42 MISSISSIPPI ST 18.** It's not very often you get to play Alabama off a straight up loss. Since the 2007 Independence Bowl, Alabama head coach Nick Saban off a straight up loss is 16-2 straight up (+17.5 ppg) and 10-8 ATS (+1.1 ppg). The last 5 times off a loss, the Tide are 5-0 SU (+24.8 ppg) and 5-0 ATS (+11.2 ppg). They're taking on a Mississippi St team fresh off a bye. However, the Bulldogs are only 2-3 ATS and +0.32 in ypp margin (No. 68) so we haven't been overly impressed with them so far. Alabama handed Mike Leach his only shutout loss of his career last year (41-0). Before you start thinking revenge, go back to Leach's days with Washington St in the Pac-12. The team with the best combo of talent and coaching (especially on defense) was rival Washington and all the Huskies did each year vs Leach was win and cover (6-0 SU/ATS with a +17.8 ppg cover margin). Obviously, Alabama has great talent and great coaching and we think Saban and company have Leach's offense figured out. Also, help us understand this line. Both teams just played at Texas A&M in their last game. Compare the spreads on those games. Alabama was -18.5. Mississippi St was +7. That assumes Alabama was 25.5 points better than Miss St on a neutral. Sure, adjust Miss St up for winning outright and Alabama down for losing but you shouldn't be adjusting team's power ratings several points this time of year. Add it all up and we're rolling with the Tide!

**WESTERN MICHIGAN 36 Kent St 30.** Western Michigan comes in off an upset loss to Ball St 45-20 as 13-point favorites. The result was misleading (see page 1). WMU is notably -0.57 in ypp margin (No. 101). They're taking on a Kent St that is +0.19 in ypp margin (No. 75) and the Golden Flashes played Texas A&M, Iowa and Maryland already this year. When you think of these two teams, you're thinking offense first. However, the two teams are a combined 9-3 to UNDER and this total was bet down from a 74.5 opener on Sunday. We're part of that UNDER money but don't have a strong lean now.

**2★ OVER 66 Western Kentucky 43 OLD DOMINION 29.** Bet WKU game totals and retire! The OVER is now 5-0 in WKU games this year going over by 16.8 ppg. We cashed last week on these pages with the UTSA/WKU OVER and it was a winner early in the 3Q. WKU is a fundamentally different team this year so all that past data points should've been thrown out. Also their opponent Old Dominion is Top 25 in the country in plays per game. The only reason this isn't a 3★ is the possibility of wind in the forecast for Saturday.

**GEORGIA 34 Kentucky 10.** The Bulldogs are not only No. 1 in the AP Poll now but are also No. 1 in our power ratings. Georgia is 5-1 ATS with a cover margin of 14.7 ppg (No. 1) and are No. 1 in scoring margin (+34.3 ppg). The Bulldogs defense is on pace to be historically good. They're taking on a Kentucky team that is 6-0 for the first time since 1950. The Wildcats are off their best performance of the season (blowout win over LSU) and are Mo. 11 in ypp margin (+2.0). Still, we think this huge spread is justified and it looks like UGA is getting healthier.



**Florida 33 LSU 24.** Just a few weeks ago, this line was probably in the "Pick-Em" range. However, it's been a disastrous last 6 quarters of football for LSU. They blew a 13-0 lead vs Auburn and then were blown out last week at Kentucky. On top of it, they have lost their top player in WR Kayshon Boutte for the season. They're really banged up as several starters are out on defense including DE Ali Gaye and CB Derek Stingley. Head coach Ed Orgeron is likely gone after this season, just two years removed from a National Title. However, we feel like all that is priced into this line with Florida a double-digit road favorite. The Gators do have revenge for losing outright as 23-point favorites last year. We're not involved even though our ratings like LSU.

**Ole Miss 45 TENNESSEE 38.** A lot of professional money is on Tennessee in this game but we disagree. The Volunteers have looked impressive as of late with back-to-back blowout wins over Missouri and South Carolina. However, those two teams are No. 75 and No. 85 in our current power ratings. They are bad Power 5 teams and now No. 11 Ole Miss and former Tennessee head coach Lane Kiffin comes to town. The Rebels are off a thrilling 52-51 win over Arkansas last week and are +1.72 in ypp margin (No. 17). Meanwhile, Tennessee is +1.44 (No. 26) despite playing an easier schedule. We like Ole Miss here. Totals' players note that this is the highest total in the history of SEC football!

**Troy 31 TEXAS ST 23.** Troy disappointed us greatly on these pages last week in a 27-24 non-covering win over Georgia Southern. The Trojans led 24-3 in the 3Q. Still, that didn't stop us from betting them again on the Sunday openers this week at a cheap -4. Texas St is one of the most over-rated teams in the country with a pair of very fortunate OT wins including last week in 4OT's vs South Alabama. We lean OVER.

**Iowa St 29 KANSAS ST 21.** Farmageddon! Both teams come in off a bye. Obviously, Iowa St is a disappointing 3-2 on the season but their stats tell a different story. The Cyclones are +210 ypg (No. 4) and are +2.67 in yards per play margin (No. 5). Meanwhile, Kansas St is a pedestrian +18 ypg (No. 71) and are +0.67 in ypp (No. 49). The Wildcats do have QB Skylar Thompson back in the line-up as he was the surprise starter vs Oklahoma a couple weeks ago. We bet Iowa St -3.5 on the openers and still lean here.

**ARKANSAS 30 Auburn 27.** Both teams need a win. The Razorbacks are off back-to-back losses albeit on the road to a couple of really good teams in Georgia and Ole Miss. Meanwhile, Auburn lost by 24 to that same Georgia team last week. Arkansas has revenge for the controversial loss to Auburn last year that involved some questionable officiating. Arkansas is +1.63 in ypp (No. 19) despite playing a tougher schedule than Auburn who is +1.56 (No. 22). That's why the Hogs are laying more than a FG. We lean OVER.

**UTSA 38 Rice 20.** UTSA comes in off a thrilling 52-46 win at WKU where we easily cashed the OVER on these pages. The Roadrunners are now 6-0 on the season and head coach Jeff Traylor is likely heading to a bigger job sometime soon. Rice comes in off a bye and the Owls have fallen short of expectation this year at 1-4 ATS. This could be a flat spot for UTSA so we're passing on the side. We do lean OVER which is 4-1 in Rice games this year.

**Utah St 32 UNLV 26.** Both teams come in off a bye. Despite their 0-5 SU record, we've actually upgraded UNLV in our power ratings this year. They've played one of the toughest schedules in the country so far and were super competitive vs Fresno St and UTSA in their last two games. Still, the Rebels are -172 ypg (No. 127), -17.8 ppg (No. 124) and -1.73 in ypp margin (No. 120). They're taking on a Utah St team that is one of the most improved in the country. The Aggies look to be healthier coming off the bye and QB Logan Bonner looks like he will start here. We lean UNDER at the current numbers as Utah St totals keep getting bet up too much in the market.

**3★ Louisiana Tech 34 UTEP 24.** A huge strength of schedule discrepancy here has us finding value on the Bulldogs. Louisiana Tech has played the No. 45 toughest schedule according to Jeff Sagarin. LT has close losses to Mississippi St, SMU and NC State. They played the North Texas game without their starting QB so their season stats have been skewed a little. Meanwhile, UTEP is 5-1. However, the Miners have played the No. 173 toughest schedule in Sagarin's ratings (includes FCS teams). UTEP has won 5 games vs teams ranked No. 122 or worse in our power ratings! They lost 54-13 to Boise St when they had to step up in competition.

**Stanford 27 WASHINGTON ST 26.** Don't look now but Washington St has won back-to-back games in Pac-12 play. They won both games outright as an underdog at Cal and vs Oregon St. That's 3 straight covers for them. Meanwhile, Stanford comes in off a loss at Arizona St. The Cardinal are also 3-3 on the season and this one already has bowl implications. Is Rolovich's vaccination status a distraction this week? We see articles mentioning it every single day. We're passing on side or total.

**NEVADA 38 Hawaii 23.** Hawaii comes in fresh off a bye. The Rainbow Warriors pulled off a shocking upset over Fresno St in their last game. It was one of the most misleading finals of the season. Hawaii outscored Fresno 17-0 in the fourth quarter, were +5 in TO's and intercepted Fresno

QB Jake Haener 3 times inside the 10-yard line! More pertinent is whether QB Chevan Cordeiro will play or not as he missed the Fresno game. Nevada is +1.59 in ypp margin (No. 21) and their backers just suffered a bad beat last week in their 55-28 non-covering win over New Mexico St (see page 1). Those misleading performances has us leaning with the Wolf Pack here!

## Week 7 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 3-7 and are 27-32 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 9 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Northern Illinois -9**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

## Week 7 CFB ATS Trends

1. Since the 2007 Independence Bowl, Alabama head coach Nick Saban off a straight up loss is 16-2 straight up (+17.5 ppg) and 10-8 ATS (+1.1 ppg). That includes all losses (end of regular season and bowls). The last 5 times off a loss, Saban is 5-0 SU (+24.8 ppg) and 5-0 ATS (+11.2 ppg).
2. The total in the Ole Miss/Tennessee game this week is 82. If that line holds, that's the highest total in any SEC game in history.
3. Virginia has won and covered 6 straight vs Duke but all of those favorite roles were by less than 7. This week they are 11-point home favorites.
4. Missouri has failed to cover the spread in 9 straight games by an average of 11.6 ppg.
5. Georgia is not only No. 1 in the AP Poll and our power ratings. The Bulldogs are also No. 1 in ATS margin this year at +14.7 ppg.

Thursday, October 14th

**Tampa Bay 30 PHILADELPHIA 23.** Philly took a lot of professional money in the market last week and that proved correct in their upset win at Carolina (outscored the Panthers 15-3 in 2H). Meanwhile, Tom Brady is simply amazing. First career game with 400-plus yards and 5 TD passes last week. The Bucs outscored the Dolphins 21-0 in the 4Q to get the blowout win and cover. We don't see much value here but do lean Tampa in a teaser down to -1.

Sunday, October 17th

† **Miami 26 Jacksonville 20.** @Tottenham Hotspur Stadium in London, England. Another 9:30am start and another London match-up with a pair of losing teams. However, we trust Miami head coach Brian Flores in this spot over Urban Meyer and the dumpster fire that is known as the Jacksonville Jaguars. We faded the Jags on these pages last week and Tennessee beat them by 18. We told you not to overthink it. There's locker-room issues in Jacksonville to say the least. Jacksonville had been to London for 7 straight years prior to COVID last year. However, that was with a different coaching staff and roster. Make it 21 straight losses for Jacksonville!

**INDIANAPOLIS 26 Houston 17.** What is the frame of mind for Indy here after blowing the big lead at Baltimore on MNF? It had looked like they were getting ready to turn their season around. Meanwhile, Houston also let one get away vs New England last week. Texans rookie QB Davis Mills was 21 of 29 for 312 yards and a 3-0 ratio becoming the first rookie QB to throw for 3 TD's vs Belichick since Russell Wilson did it in 2012. This is the Colts first home game in a month. We're passing.

**Green Bay 26 CHICAGO 20.** That's now 4 straight wins and covers for the Packers since the opening day blowout loss to the Saints as QB Rodgers has a 10-1 TD-to-INT ratio in those games. This is their 3rd road game in 4 weeks but the Packers have owned the Bears at Soldier Field winning 10 of their last 11 trips there. In fact, the Packers are 21-4 straight up and 18-7 ATS vs the Bears since 2009. Aaron Rodgers vs a rookie QB? Yes, the Bears have won 3 of their last 4 games but they've beaten Cincy and Detroit at home and took on a very distracted Las Vegas team last week. When they had to step up in competition, they were blown out at the Rams and Browns.

**Kansas City 33 WASHINGTON 26.** Kansas City is now 2-13-1 ATS in their last 16 games. That's historically bad in the NFL. Their point-spreads don't get adjusted enough because they are also 11-5 SU in those 16 games. You think this might be a "Buy Low" spot for them off the blowout loss to the Bills, however, the "look-ahead" line was -5.5/-6. Mahomes already has 6 interceptions this season, as many as he had all of last year and the Chiefs defense is allowing 33 ppg on the year. We cashed fading Washington last week on these pages. Their defense remains one of the biggest disappointments in the NFL as they have allowed 34 ppg in their last 4 games and it won't get any better this week. These two teams are a combined 8-2 to the OVER this year.

**CAROLINA 23 Minnesota 22.** There were several sharp betting groups that faded Carolina last week and the Panthers lost outright to the Eagles at home (outscored 15-3 in the second half). What's very troublesome is QB Darnold throwing 5 interceptions the last two games. Meanwhile, the Vikings nearly lost outright to the Lions last week as they got a 54-yard FG on the as time expired. Minnesota did have a 384-288 yard edge. The Vikings are playing their first road game in a month. We're seeing money come in against the Panthers again. However, if RB McCaffery returns, we lean with Carolina.

**BALTIMORE 27 L.A. Chargers 26.** A possible playoff preview here. Chargers' QB Justin Herbert continues to impress including last week with 398 yards and a 4-0 ratio in a shoot-out win over the Browns. Keep in mind, that was a Cleveland defense that had allowed just 184 passing ypg coming in. They're catching a Baltimore team fresh off a fortunate MNF comeback win in OT over Indianapolis. Yes, we know the Chargers have a new regime but their limited home-field advantage throughout the years as created value on them when they play away from home. LAC is 20-10-2 ATS as a road underdog since 2015.

**Cincinnati 24 DETROIT 22.** Cincy comes in off the OT loss to the Packers last week. They had their chances but came up short as QB Burrow continues to take a beating. They're taking on a Detroit team that knows a thing or two about losing close games late as the Lions now have lost 2 games this season on long FG's as time expired. They might be 0-5 SU on the season but Dan Campbell and company are 3-2 ATS and this team plays hard for 60 minutes. We lean Detroit and the UNDER here.

**L.A. Rams 28 N.Y. GIANTS 20.** The Rams have extra rest after beating Seattle last week on the road. QB Stafford continues to show why he's an upgrade over Goff. They're taking on a Giants team that was devastated by injury last week losing RB Barkley to an ankle, QB Jones to a concussion and WR Galloway to a knee. This was already a Giants offense dealing with cluster injuries at WR and a banged up OL. It does look like Jones will play here. Remember, the Giants are much better as away underdogs than home dogs but we lean with them here and the UNDER.

**2★ CLEVELAND 26 Arizona 20.** The Cardinals got us on these pages last week in their 17-10 win over the 49ers to remain the lone unbeaten team at 5-0. It's their first 5-0 start as a franchise since 1974. Meanwhile, the Browns became the first team in NFL history to lose when scoring 40-plus points, notching 500 or more yards and having ZERO TO's. Cleveland does lead the NFL in rushing offense and Arizona isn't great defending it. We lean UNDER here as the early weather forecasts are calling for 19 mph winds. We also like Cleveland here as their ground attack is much better suited for the weather.

**DENVER 23 Las Vegas 19.** Obviously, the story here is Jon Gruden resigning 3-plus seasons into a 10-year contract. There were obvious distractions last week as they lost outright to the Bears at home. We think his departure hurts the Raiders offensive game-planning more than anything. Both teams are coming off back-to-back losses after starting out 3-0. Denver feasted upon 3 bad teams in the Giants, Jags and Jets to start the season. That made them overrated in the market. Too many unknowns to be involved here on the side but we do lean UNDER which has cashed in 8 of the last 9 meetings.

**2★ NEW ENGLAND 25 Dallas 24.** Dallas is a perfect 5-0 ATS on the season. They are the only team to cover all 5 games this season. However, we feel you're starting to pay a premium on them here especially considering they just won 3 straight games all at home against teams that will likely be .500 or worse at season's end (Philly, Carolina and the Giants). Meanwhile, the Pats overcame a 22-9 deficit to avoid an embarrassing loss to the Texans. They were playing without 4 offensive line starters (COVID) who should all return here. New England has lost their first 3 home games for the first time since 1993. We expect max effort just like the Tampa Bay near upset win.
