

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

March 28, 2016

The Jewell County Commissioners met March 28, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners, Steve Greene, Mark Fleming and Dwight S. Frost present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was also present.

The minutes of the March 21, 2016 County Commissioners meeting were approved as printed.

The Commissioners conducted office head meeting. The following were present for the meeting: Chris Petet, Custodian; Anna Standley, Register of Deeds; Gail Bartley, Noxious Weed Director, Emergency Preparedness Director and 911 Coordinator; Angela Murray, Health Nurse; Joel Elkins, General Superintendent; Don Jacobs, Sheriff and Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director. The following were absent: Chuck Latham, County Appraiser; Jenae Ryan, District Extension Agent; Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director; Brenda Eakins, Treasurer.

Travis Garst said he plans to attend a conference in Garden City. He reported the HHW permit has been renewed.

Joel Elkins said they have been working on tubes. They are working on a rock project by Caldwell Cemetery south of Formoso.

Gail Bartley reported that 26 people attended the storm spotters meeting. Gail will be working at the Weed Director's booth at the Salina Farm Show this week.

Chris Petet said that the trees have been trimmed.

Angela Murray said she is working on grant applications for the next year. They are trying to get the office situated.

Anna Standley said she plans to attend the April 14th Telnet continuing education class and the District Meeting at Washington on April 15th.

Don Jacobs said the Ford pickup was delivered and Ken's Body Works had put on the decals.

Carla Waugh said the auditors will be here next week. She said payroll is this week. She discussed the upcoming elections.
