How to sign up for a club:

1. See the teacher in charge of your club to get a permission slip.
2. Bring your **signed** permission slip back to your teacher.
3. Students must go to their locker before the club. You must be on time to your club?

Mondays:

1. 9th Period: Students will attend 9th period for study skills and organizational help. Students will meet in room 282 from 3:15-4:15. See Mrs. Roig for details.
2.
