- 8) You will be billed monthly. - c) subject to the paragraph 10 - Non-Standard Connection provisions of this Agreement, basic configuration of your equipment to allow an initial connection to the BST Ltd. access point and wireless signal including dish pointing, configuration of radio software, and establishment of connection on a single personal computing device at the time of installation; and
 - d) monitoring and reporting on the status of BST Ltd. Internet Access up to the point your equipment accesses the BST Ltd. wireless signal.

8. You Can Best Control the Risk and Therefore Are Responsible

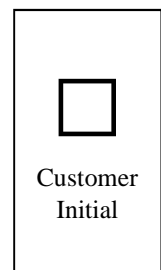
