

CIMARRON CIA POOL RULES

1. LIFEGUARDS HAVE FULL AUTHORITY TO DISCIPLINE UNRULEY PERSONS AND TO ENFORCE THE RULES.
2. Parents, not lifeguards, are responsible for children in the small pool.
3. All swimmers must wear proper suits; properly hemmed t-shirts are allowed over suits. Cut-offs are not allowed as swimwear.
4. No running, pushing, dunking or rough-housing.
5. Only proper swim diapers are allowed in the large pool or baby pool.
6. No pets allowed.
7. Floating will be allowed when there are less than 25 people in the pool. Protective supports for small children will be allowed.
8. Only one person at a time allowed on the slide and diving board.
9. Do not hold or hang on rope.
10. Children under age 10 as of September 1st, may not be at pool without adult supervision.
11. Guest must be accompanied by a resident. Limit 4 guests per family at a time.
12. All glass and glass containers are prohibited.
13. Any child who depends on flotation devices to stay above water must be accompanied by an adult while in the pool.
14. No objects of any kind will be thrown in the pool area.
15. All rules apply to adults as well as children.
16. I.D. cards must be produced at all times.
17. Improper or immoral behavior is prohibited.
18. No loud music in the pool area.
19. Anyone caught swimming after hours will not only be suspended from the pool but is also subject to prosecution for trespassing.
20. If fecal matter is found in the pool, the pool will be closed until approved by the pool cleaning company.
21. Opening of the pool may be delayed if broken glass presents a hazard.
22. No swimmer expelled from the pool with a disciplinary notice will be readmitted until swimmer's parents have satisfied the pool management and/or subdivision board of directors of their intent to control said swimmer's undesirable behavior.
23. Children may not sit on the edge of the pool during adult swim.
24. Lifeguards are not responsible for children in the small pool.
25. Smoking in designated area only.

Violation of these rules may result in loss of pool privileges.
