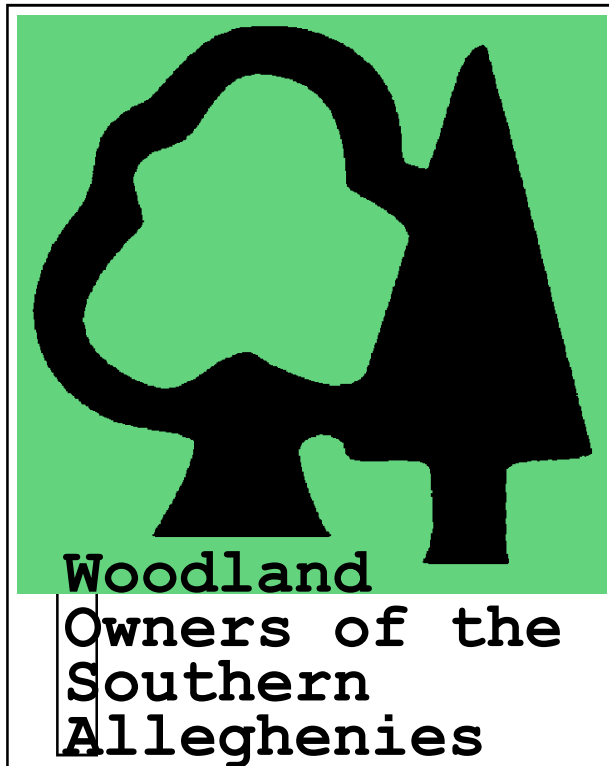


Purposes of WOSA

3. *Achieve recognition as an organized voice of forest landowners in the region.*

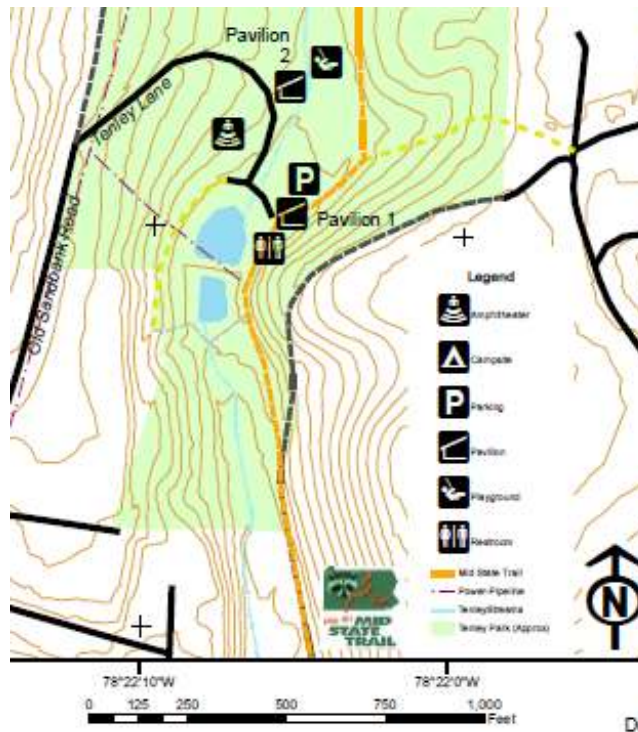


To Tenley Park:

From the east, at OIP/Rite Aid on E. Main St in Everett:
Turn Right at the Light on N Hopewell St
Turn left at E 1st St
Turn right at N Hopewell St and head up the hill
Take the 4th right into Tenley Park (wooden sign at entrance)

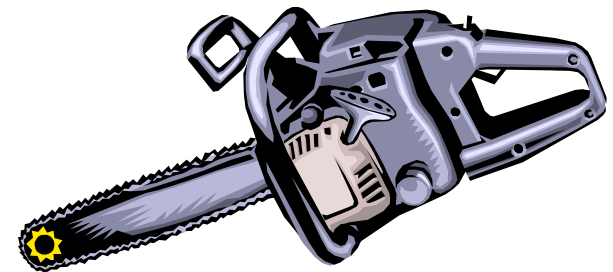
From the west, by Sheetz on W. Main St in Everett:
