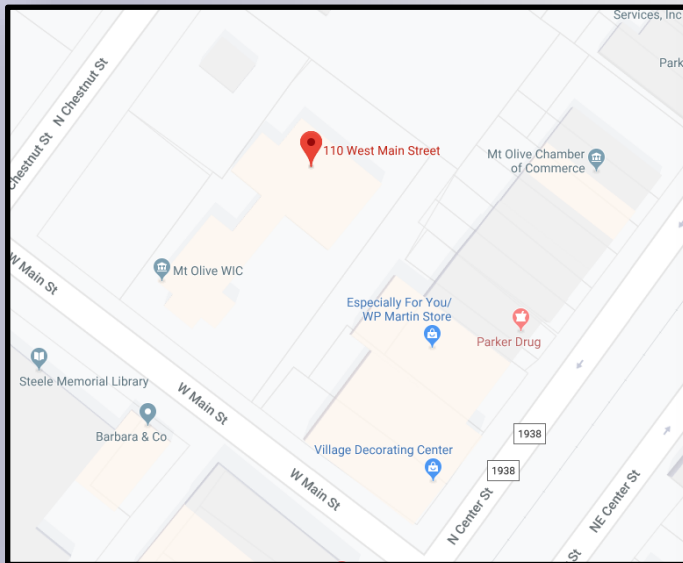


# Mt Olive Precinct Merger!



**Precincts #25 (Mt Olive Train Depot) and #30 (Southern Academy) have been combined into Precinct #2530 and will vote at:**

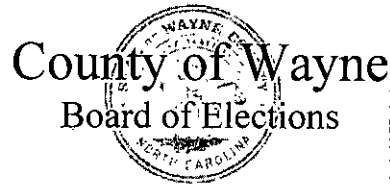

Resolution of the  
Wayne County Board of Elections

WHEREAS, the Town of Mt Olive is currently divided into two relatively small precincts in a manner that is often confusing to voters; and


WHEREAS, the Wayne County Board of Elections has received various complaints regarding the polling place for Precinct #30, has found few viable options for relocation, and has determined that the polling place for Precinct #25 is adequate to accommodate all registered voters in both precincts; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. § 163A-1071 authorizes the alteration of precinct boundaries pending approval by the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections; and


WHEREAS, the Wayne County Board of Elections determined at its December 10, 2019 regularly scheduled meeting that the Mt Olive Train Depot, located at 110 W Main Street, Mt Olive, NC 28365, would be the polling place for the newly formed Precinct #2530, a combination of the previously numbered Precincts #25 and #30.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wayne County Board of Elections, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 163A-1071, and by unanimous vote, hereby approves the combination of Precinct #25 and Precinct #30 into a newly formed Precinct #2530 Mt Olive Train Depot with no alterations to the exterior boundaries, beginning with the March 3, 2020 Presidential Preference Primary.

This Resolution is effective this 10<sup>th</sup> day of December 2019.






