**DESCRIPTION:** The Hoyt Pro Custom was Hoyt's best bow until the Pro Medalist came out. The long length makes for a very smooth shot. The 27# draw weight make this an ideal youth or ladies bow, or a guy who can no longer hold a heavy draw weight. This old gal has been restored. The riser and yellow limbs were stripped and refinished. (I saved the original logos but you can see the deep yellowing that was preserved around the logos). This bow is still in great shape. The 5-layer tip overlays still look brand new. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The only structural flaw is a 1 1/2 inch scratch on the edge of the upper face limb (see pic on last page) Decal is in good shape. This bow has been shot tested and was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.

This bow sold for \$80 in the early '60's (twice the price as the Bear Grizzly), which translates to \$817 in 2024 inflation adjusted dollars.
