For the most excitement, we will head to the Flagler Avenue entrance where you will be sure to have a memorable experience.

After our buses arrive in New Smyrna Beach, passengers will be dropped at the Flagler Avenue Beachfront Park. Along with relaxing on the beach, you can begin your trip by checking out the charming shops by the sea or enjoying lunch at a top-rated restaurant known for its award-winning cuisine.

Because this beach allows auto traffic, we'll all need to be careful when crossing the sand to avoid becoming a hood ornament. The beach has beautiful white sand and is watched over by lifeguards. Restrooms and showers are available. It is a great place to enjoy and have fun in the sun!

New Smyrna Beach has the highest number of shark attacks each year compared to anywhere else in the world. Despite this, the majority of attacks near Ponce de Leon inlet involve minor bites from juvenile bull sharks, with no fatalities reported.
