

ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 11-18-18, NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE, WHERE APPLICABLE, BEFORE DISTURBING CERTAIN GROUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Rolla, North Dakota:

Section 1. When a notice provided for in Section 11-18-16 of the North Dakota Century Code has been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds, any person intending to conduct any digging, grading, leveling, excavating, blasting, or similar activities upon the lands described in the notice, at least three days, not counting Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, before the commencement of the activity, shall request the person owning or controlling the facilities to accurately locate them upon the land where they are situated. Within the three days, the owner or person controlling the facilities shall accurately locate them and provide this information to the person requesting it.

Section 2. Penalties. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court; the Court to have power to suspend said sentence and to revoke the suspension thereof.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and take effect immediately upon its final passage and the publication of its title and penalty clause.
