

The problem there, like purchasing on line, is finding the proper clothing materials. Most Revolutionary clothing was Cotton, Linens and wools. Modern fabrics get HOT in the summer and COLD in the winter. Natural materials are better wearing and easier to take care of. Uniforms can be an expensive purchase either Off the rack or from scratch. I paid almost \$1,000 just for the material, buttons, etc
