This week teach your children the three parts of the Grace Before Meals prayer. As we prepare for Thanksgiving this week, think of all the things you are grateful for as a family and write them down on a list to see. Consider collecting some canned foods to take to a food pantry so families in need can have a good meal as well.

Why do we say Grace before meals?

The custom of praying and 'giving thanks' for our meals is an ancient one – going back even before Jesus as a part of the Jewish tradition. Several Early Church Fathers said we pray before our meals as a way to be **thankful** and as a way to **praise God**.

The prayer we say before meals today came from Pope Gelasius who lived at the end of the 5th century – that was a looong time ago. This short prayer follows three of the four main types of prayer – supplication, gratitude, and praise:

Supplication: "Bless us, O Lord"

Gratitude: "and these, thy gifts, which we are about to receive from thy bounty,"

Praise: "through Christ our Lord, Amen."

That's a lot of prayer for such a short prayer! What an awesome way to give thanks every day.

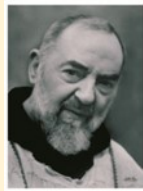


Christmas/New Year's Camp
