Dear Parents,

The year is quickly flying by! This means our state's standardized tests are coming up. Our school has been preparing for this and working hard for these upcoming tests.

We can make your child's test experience positive and successful by working together. Please take the time to do these little things and help your child reach his or her fullest potential:

- ◆ **Talk with your child about goals for this test.**
- ◆ **No cell phones or smart watches are allowed on campus during testing. The STATE department will confiscate phones and watches until all files are cleared for a possible testing breach.**
- ◆ **Make sure your child gets a healthy breakfast at home or at school on the morning of the test.**
- ◆ **Late students will make up missed sessions after lunch in the library. They will NOT be allowed to enter a testing session that has begun.**
- ◆ **Gently encourage your child to do their best and show your faith in them.**

Below you will find a list of dates your child will test based on his or her current grade.

- **April 9—13 is 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grades (Monday-Friday) STRICTLY Timed**
- **April 16—20 is 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grades (Monday-Friday) STRICTLY Timed**
- **April 30—May 4 is 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grades (Monday-Friday) STRICTLY Timed**
- **April 30—May 3 – High School EOC Testing for Eng. I, Eng. II and Eng. III (Monday-Thursday) STRICTLY Timed**
- **May 7—10 – High School EOC Testing for US History, Biology and Geometry (Monday-Thursday) ALL will be STRICTLY Timed except biology**
- **May 14—15 – High School EOC testing for Algebra I (Monday-Tuesday) STRICTLY Timed**

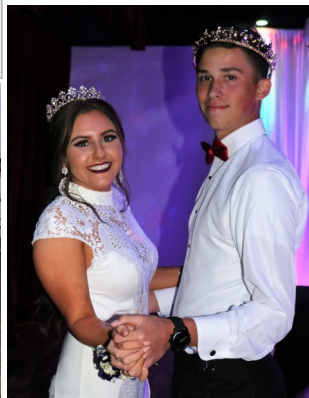

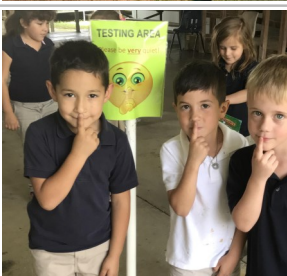

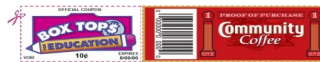
