November Clinic

We had a varied and interesting night, members are now encouraged to bring in items for a swap sale, anything clean, no potential leaking items are welcome. As always Phil's presentation has the actual items in various stages of assembly, and each is well presented so we as his students see how they are built and how they must function. He showed us the original cut outs, contrasted them with the reproduction ones and also discussed the solid state modern types. The term "cut out "describes the actual part and also, it's electrical function, however it also is a "cut in" when the charging system requires a need to satisfy another one of the charging functions. It makes one wonder why we ignor one of it's function in it's description.

Our library of books and videos were present and to set the mood Gary Thorin brought a very old Edison phonograph and played music from the early days.

Coffee and cookies were provided and Steve Barnacle and Dave Peterson set up to make that happen. This was another enjoyable night of a very diverse group of people with a common interest in the Model A Ford. Always feel free to bring a friend or a family member along to one of these clinic and let them experience the great information and interesting people in attendace.
