

Prayers Week 7 - Day 1- *Exodus 2:11 - 13*

God of grace and power, You created us with a sense and essence of who we are, whose we are, and where we came from. At our core we are yours, but we still have another identity while we are here. You placed that there also. Help us remember it is for carrying out your plans for us and for your people.

Day 2 - *Exodus 3:11*

Lord, help us not fear the bush that burns before us. You have put it there to bring us to you. You have also put it there to bring others to you and to deliver them from their oppressors. When we approach this fire, we are at the heart and essence and our being. Help us remember that we are covered by your wings of protection and robes of righteousness. Day 3 - *Exodus 2:19 and Exodus 3:1*

Jesus, like you, Moses' people did not even recognize him at first, but they recognized his servant nature and humility. He was prepared to lead and to serve through his daily service as a shepherd. He first led a flock to the far side of the desert but he later led a people. Help us to know Jesus, that you are using us everyday for your Kingdom. You are preparing us for greater works.

Day 4 - *3 John 3 and Psalm 45:7*

Jesus, you were known for your joy. Our gifts, our calling, our countenance should express joy when we are walking in your will and in your gifting. Our greatest joy is experienced when we are operating in our gifting and under your anointing. Our greatest joy should be to see your children coming to know you and worship you, no matter if we are in the ministry or the marketplace. Help us know what true joy is and know the true joy of serving you with passion and with zeal.

Day 5- *Psalm 69:9 and John 2:17*

Jesus, you were a man of passion. You were on fire with concern for what was important to you. Let our hearts burn for the things you have set before us and within us to accomplish your good works. Help us recognize the passion you have given us. Help us to embrace it as you did. It is the heat that keeps the fire for your Kingdom burning. You gave us passion and zeal to do your holy purposes. Teach us to recognize the fire burning within us for you and your house.

Day 6 - *Matthew 9:36*

Jesus, you encountered the helpless and the needy at every turn. We also encounter those who are in need. Help us know when it is our place and in our gifting and calling to help. Even you passed by many. Give us peace to let go, but give us strength to take hold of what you call us to. Help us learn to know when our calling and the need intersect. Help us also remember that there are others with different gifts and passions to fill those gaps. You have provided for all.

Day 7 - *Mark 1:15-17*

Jesus, you call us from our ordinary lives and our ordinary tasks to be coworkers in your Kingdom. You equip us daily, and you call us from where we are and who we are. Help us and teach us to understand this concept. Teach us to understand the joy set before us and the passion that should consume us. Let our "doing" flow like a river from our "being." Help us see the shape of the vessel that you have designed and help us! AMEN
