Watch the weather forecast and prepare your frost protection for cold nights.

Plant onion transplants (slips) whenever the soil is workable. Start tomatoes and peppers indoors towards the end of the month. Plant asparagus root crowns as soon as they are available at the nursery. Add quick-growing winter crops like lettuce and radishes to empty spaces when the weather is mild.
