Tuesday's agenda for the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors includes work on an Industrial Hemp Ordinance [39], dwelling units for the homeless [14], a possible extension of the Paso Robles

Groundwater Basin moratorium [21], and adoption of the 2019/20 Budget [38].

### PARADE NEWS

Here's some important information from the Rotary Club of Templeton regarding this year's parade...

**PARADE ENTRIES:** Applications are still being accepted for this year's parade. All family, church, and service oriented groups are FREE. There is a \$10 application fee for clubs - with Car Clubs encouraged to consider a \$10 per car donation. Commercial participants will be charged \$50 - business branding is allowed. Please **CLICK HERE** for an application or pick one up at either TCSD (5th & Crocker)

or the Chamber office (321-C S. Main Street).

### ROAD CLOSURES, PARKING AND SHUTTLE

On the day of the parade, Main Street will be closed WITHOUT EXCEPTION at 8:30 am. Templeton Rotary will provide shuttle bus transportation from 8:30 am to 2 pm from parking lots on N. Main and the Vineyard Lot (across 101).

When the parade route is closed, only Old County Road will remain open to access

downtown Templeton. When parking areas are full, "PARKING FULL" signs will be posted along each street. After 9 am, only parking areas North and South of Templeton will be accessible by car.

### **HANDICAPPED PARKING AND RESTROOMS**

Handicapped Parking will be available at the Presbyterian Church (6th and S. Main). A handicap accessible restroom will be placed at the location as well.

This year, there will be additional port-a-potties for parade attendees. Please be a good neighbor and avoid using local business restrooms.

### **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH**

Due to a dog chasing a parade horse at last year's event, we are now required to alert attendees that all dogs **MUST** be on a leash.

### **ROOTBEER FLOATS**

Templeton Rotary will be selling "All American Rootbeer Floats" along the parade route from John Deere tractors. Please note that Rotary is responsible for any and all parade route refreshments.

### **CHILDREN'S SAFETY**

Please ensure that your children are safe and keep them far from the street, the parade participants, and all cross traffic.

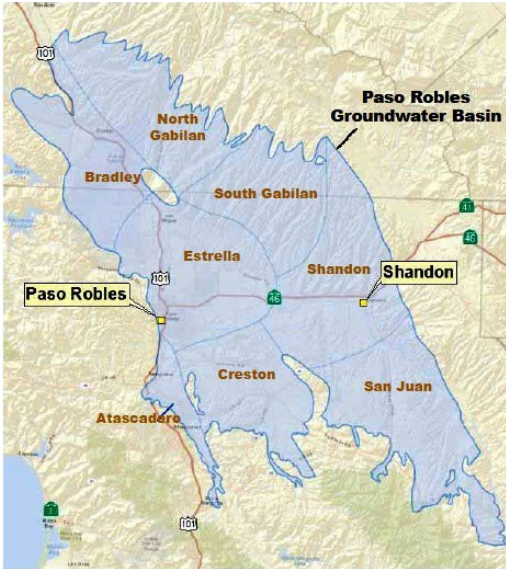
