2024 Dressage Rule Changes & New State Championships Date

There have been some changes to the Dressage Rules that will apply from 1 January 2024:

- From 1 January 2024, Gear checking is now to be performed immediately AFTER leaving the arena. A Gear Check is compulsory for each test and failure to have a gear check will entail elimination.
- The Dressage Committee is also calling for people to train as Stewards. Competitive events now need at least one Level 1 Nationally accredited Dressage Steward or higher-level Steward. Anyone wishing to train should contact Jude Sonnefeld at Equestrian SA for more information.
- The SA Dressage Championships will now be held on 2 and November 2024.

Judging Opportunity -

Hawkesbury Dressage Festival 14th to 23rd June

Hawkesbury Dressage Club is running their fabulous Festival again this year at the Sydney International Equestrian Centre, Horsley Park, NSW. There is added excitement this year as it is to include the final selection events for the Para Equestrian team for Paris! There will be two International Judges attending and the possibility of some added workshops with them at some point. Keep watch on the HDC website: hawkesburydressage.com.au.

The Club would like to offer the following in the spirit of improving judging opportunities across the country. Hawkesbury Dressage Club will pay Judges the going rate for judging tests plus the maximum travel and expenses rate (\$350 max) and refreshments on judging days as applicable. This will leave the Judges with other expenses, accommodation, car hire and meals etc that could possibly be either self funded or funded by their EA branch or State Dressage Committee. They will be able to utilise Judges from E level upwards and would also try and offer shadow judging, mentoring etc as required.

The dates are: 14th to 23rd June and the programme at this stage will be Prep to Grand Prix and Para team tests on the first (14th/15th) and second weekend (22nd/23rd), plus two mid week days (possibly Tuesday and Wednesday) and Freestyles on the Friday (21st).

Rule Changes effective 1st January 2024

There are several Rule changes effective from 1st January. Some of the key changes are listed below, however we recommend reading the summary on the EA Website.

1.6.1 Yellow Card Warning - Clarifying the consequences of not complying with Stallion Identification Rules

A Yellow Warning Card may be imposed for failure to comply with Stallion Identification as per the Stallion Safe Practice Rules and Regulations Policy.

3.4 Timing of the Draw - highlighting that competition draws should be random

- combinations should be listed in random order on the draw. The same combinations should not follow each other in draws if possible.
- every effort should be made to not have the same combination drawn first in more than one test at any one event.

3.12.2 Clarify time frames for the application of competition rules

Competition Rules apply once a competitor arrives at a venue.

4.4 Gear Check. To align with the FEI Gear Check requirements, Gear check is to be performed immediately after leaving the arena

- a) A Gear Check is compulsory for each test and failure to have a gear check will entail elimination
- b) An Accredited Steward (or approved representative of the Steward) must be appointed to check the Saddlery of each Horse immediately after it leaves the arena. Any discrepancy will be reported to the Judge at C. The checking of the bridle must be done with the greatest caution, as some Horses are very sensitive about their mouths.
- c) If the Steward discovers fresh blood in the Horse's mouth or in the area of the spurs during the check at the end of the test, they inform the Judge at C, who will eliminate the Horse and the Athlete
- d) If the Steward discovers fresh blood on other parts of the horse they inform the Judge at C.
- e) A visual check before leaving the last warm up arena may be conducted by the Stewards to prevent Athletes going into the field of play with any forbidden equipment. A visual check can be declined, as it is designed to help Athletes but is not compulsory. However, it remains the full responsibility of the Athlete not to enter with any forbidden piece of Saddlery.

6.4 Stewards - Implementation of the Rule requiring competitive events to have a Level 1 or higher Steward appointed to the event and section reviewed

All official Competitive events must have a minimum of one Level 1 Nationally accredited Dressage Steward or higher-level Steward appointed. For larger events the number of Stewards appointed should be appropriate to the number of competition and warm up areas in use in accordance with recommendations from the appointed Chief Steward. If this is not possible, the OC can apply to the EADC at least 30 days prior to commencement of each event to use a National Candidate Steward, until 31 December 2024. The National Candidate Steward will then assume the duties of a Steward for that event only.

Annex D - Arena Familiarisation

- Any arena familiarisation and warm-up areas should must be supervised by a an accredited Steward
- OCs should ensure designated first aid official/medical service providers are present once the event has officially started; this includes arena familiarisation periods.





No horsing around in getting new base ready

MONTHS of hard work have paid off as one of South Australia's oldest dressage clubs officially opened their new home ground in Lewiston over the weekend.

The South Australian Dressage Association (SADA) cut the ribbon to its new home base at Lyrical Acres as part of its annual club championship on Sunday, December 3.

The search for a suitable home deck has been years in the making, with floods in 2016 washing away their old arena surfaces at Gawler River Pony Club.

SADA president Anne Smith was feeling very positive about the club's future as it settled into its new grounds.

"I'm incredibly proud of the SADA committee and members, the development of the club has been amazing," Ms Smith said.

"I am looking forward to increasing our membership in the future and con-

tinuing to improve our grounds, while still catering for all levels of riders from led to FEI."

The last five months alone have seen the club leap forward, with works including the resurfacing of their indoor area, creating a new outdoor warm up area and a club room all coming together.

For SADA committee member Anita Trenwith, watching everyone work to get the club to this point has been "just incredible" to see.

"We received some grant money from the Office of Recreation, Sport and Racing to develop our grounds and they have been super supportive as we worked hard to secure our home base," Ms Trenwith said.

"We have already exceeded our initial plans for the facility, with not only the two competition arenas and warm up area, but also club rooms, horse yards, lunging arena and secure equine fencing around the entire facility."

This emblem signifies a large part of our Club's history, and has been relatively unchanged for at least a decade. This horse and rider silhouette shape was featured as far back as 2012 on rosettes found in the move to our new grounds. SADA worked with Sophie Hales to make subtle changes to the existing silhouette and add details that convey more of our story.



Within the updated design the saddle blanket and breeches are not white to represent our Club level competition, but the rider wears tails and uses a double bridle to symbolise the higher levels available at SADA. HOTY, POTY and YOTY are "AHDC Members only" Awards

Riders must be full financial members of AHDC at the competition when they ride their test/s (Day Members are NOT included) to have their points counted.

Points in a class are awarded to AHDC members only, regardless of how many riders in a class. They are then ranked into the top six placings. So if a member places 2nd in a class (behind a non-member), they will be awarded 6 points as the AHDC member winner of that class and so on.

1st place - 6 points, 2nd place - 5 points, 3rd place - 4 points, 4th place - 3 points, 5th place - 2 points, 6th place - 1 point. Points are recorded during the year and include scores over 55% from all of our competitions except (February CT, April Protocol day and October Spring festival). The results are updated on our website so riders can all see where they are standing throughout the year.

However there are now additional points available to allow more members to obtain points.

The second set of points is based on the % score (similar to EA point allocation). Eg. first place (for AHDC members only) with 65% would get 6 points for the place and another 3 points for their score = 9 points in total.

Between 60% to 61.999% 1 point
Between 62% to 63.999% 2 points
Between 64% to 65.999% 3 points
Between 66% to 67.999% 4 points
Between 68% to 69.999% 5 points
Between 70% to 71.999% 6 points
72% and over 7 points

The current Round started with the November 2023 competition.



From the Committee

Wow ... what crazy weather!

We made the decision to cancel our 9 December 2023 competition as large areas of the State were rated as catastrophic on the Friday before the competition: temperatures were in the 40's. Our 20 January 2024 competition went ahead- it was a close call with the forecast maximum temperature being 34 degrees. In the interest of horse welfare and as a welcome to the new year, the Committee made the decision to provide the undercover stables and shady yards free of charge for this event. This initiative was truly welcomed by all who attended, horses and riders alike. This smaller event proved to be a valuable learning opportunity for us to master the tablets and print out the results. A massive thank you from me to Margaret Sexton, together we successfully achieved all of the above on the fly (stressful as it was LOL).

We are now providing CUR riders with three dress code options-

- Formal: jacket, white breeches, white saddle pad etc.
- MCDC uniform - MCDC top and white breeches, white saddle pad)
- Smart Casual - coloured breeches, coloured saddle pad, coloured top-as you would for a clinic or a lesson).

The Pony Pantry (Sam and Melinda Coleshill) continue to provide absolutely stunning food:

- homemade
- fresh
- gluten free options
- icy cold drinks
- muffins
- wraps

The feedback has been 100% positive, with everyone proactively commenting on how yummy their food is. Well done Sam and Mel.

We are absolutely delighted to welcome Molly Ellis to the Committee. Molly is an exceptionally gifted artist and highly proficient at all things digital. We are all truly grateful to have you on board.

A big thank you to Rachael Britton who set up our 2024 membership data on Nominat - a big job indeed. Rachael has decided to leave the Committee due to work commitments and her daughter's impending marriage.

We have sold a couple of assets to "keep the wolves from the door" - namely the generator and the unused container.

17 March 2024: The MCDC Jackpot Bonanza Preliminary through to Grand Prix with cash prizes


- CASH prizes for each level winner (Champion) Prelim, Novice, Elementary, Medium, Advanced, FEI small tour and FEI Medium tour
