### Salute to "Outstanding" Honorees Award

The BHRC may select to present "Special" awards to individuals who provide outstanding support and service to further the work of the **NATIONAL COUNCIL OFNEGRO WOMEN** in the local community.

In keeping with the ceremony's intent to salute its honorees in the Bethune-Height Recognition Program, no more than **TWO AWARDS** will be presented.

- Outstanding Women in Industry (Careers)
- Distinguished Community Leader (Business, Civic, etc.)
- Outstanding Volunteer
- Outstanding Humanitarian
- Leader in the Arts, Science, Journalist, Correspondent
- Distinguished Educator
- Youth Leader

#### **State Honoree**

The Bethune-Height Recognition Committee may at times select an NCNW member as a <u>State Honoree</u>. This person would be selected based on the outstanding work done to advance NCNW programs at the local level. The Committee selects and prepares this Award.

#### **National Affiliates Group or Contributing Partner**

The BHRC may also select to honor an Affiliate Group or an outstanding contributing or cooperating partner who has provided exemplary service and assistance to the community based NCNW programs.
