

Hello to Our Woodland Neighbors,

We held our Annual Meeting this past Sunday, March 26th, 2017. We would like to share those results with you. Our budget line items, reserve account projects and newly created bylaws all passed- see below for complete budget numbers. However, we had a first for the Woodlands, a tie for 5th place for the last seat on the Board of Directors. Because we did not have a policy that we could follow for this scenario we were advised by our legal counsel and auditing firm that this election would have to be null and void.

From 45 days of this email we will have a special meeting to announce the results of the Board of Directors. You will only have two ways to vote: 1. by mail or 2. you must be present at the meeting to cast your ballot. No proxy ballots based on the new bylaws will be accepted.

The purpose of this special meeting will be ONLY to vote for the candidates to the Board of Directors. The ballot you will receive will have no candidates removed or added.

In the next week or so you will receive a new ballot to cast your vote again for your choice for a Board of Directors; It will have a ballot with instructions and a return envelope.
