2016 Getaway Classic

Time is rapidly approaching to get your entries in for this year's Getaway Classic in Laughlin. For new members and those "old" members who have never participated, this is a really fun event that includes golf on some good courses, socializing with other members, and imbibing of a few adult beverages (purely optional). There are a couple changes this year. First, the hotel contract is with the Edgewater Hotel & Casino—the cost would have increased had we stayed with the Aquarius. Individuals still have the option to stay where they wish—the Edgewater is right across a parking lot from the Aquarius. The other change is that the Board decided guests with an established handicap will be eligible for gross skins and closests—not net skins. They always have the option to join the EMPC before the Getaway and be eligible for everything. The significant dates are as follows:

2016 Rules Changes

For 2016, there are several changes to the Rules of Golf and the USGA Handicap rules.

One change to the handicap system is that rounds played alone cannot be posted. Since the game is based on trust and self-enforcement of the rules, this change has generated plenty of controversy online and in the press, including major golf magazines. The USGA is trying to promote more peer review and crack down on those who manipulate their handicap by not trying their best, or posting inaccurately, which is even easier in the internet age.

Regardless of how you feel about it, as a SCGA sanctioned club, we're stuck with it for now, so no use complaining to the club about it – direct your opinions to the USGA.

This is also a good time to remind you that "peer review" is not the Handicap Chairman's job - it is the

responsibility of every player in the club. If somebody in your group shoots the round of the day, did he post it? Go ahead and ask or check vou owe it to the rest of the club to verify it. If you hear about somebody who had great round а somewhere else, mention it to Fred Wallace or any board member, and we'll be glad to make sure it was posted correctly.

Enhance Peer Review

The concept of "peer review" is an essential element of the USGA Handicap System". It allows other players to learn a player's potential ability and to form a reasonable basis for supporting or disputing a score that has been posted. Without peer review, a Handicap Index" loses its inherent value, and is just a number.

Strengthen the Integrity and Credibility of the USGA Handicap System

Players are not prohibited from playing alone, only from posting solo-round scores for handicap purposes. By playing alone, a player loses the advantage of someone alongside who can remind the player of a Rule or verify that they made a 5 and not a 6. Handicap controls, a series of checks and balances that have always been a part of the USGA Handicap System, ensure that a Handicap Index will accurately measure a player's potential ability. They exist to assist the golf club and the Handicap Committee with its responsibilities. The amendment to clarify a round played alone as an unaccept-able score is an important part of building greater confidence in a player's Handicap Index.





Global Game

Societal trends such as globalization and technology are making our world a smaller place. Golfers are traveling and competing with one another more today than ever. Therefore, this change will further enhance the credibility of the USGA Handicap System worldwide.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why will scores made while playing alone no longer be eligible for posting?

Primarily, to support a key tenet of the USGA Handicap System: peer review. Knowing golfers rely on the integrity of the system to produce an accurate view of playing ability, this change helps golfers form a better basis to support or dispute scores that have been posted to a player's scoring record.

The majority of handicapping authorities around the globe have employed this policy for some time. With them, the USGA believes it provides a more accurate view of a golfer's ability, supporting integrity, fairness and equitable play among all golfers.

What constitutes not playing alone?

As long as someone accompanies the player during the round (e.g., fellow competitor, opponent, caddie, marker for a tournament, friend riding along in a cart) the player is not playing alone. How many holes can a player play alone to post their score? The player must be accompanied for at least seven holes for a ninehole score or 13 holes for an 18-hole score. This is consistent with Section 5-1 and the minimum number of holes played under the Rules of Golf.

> For the holes played alone (unaccompanied), the player would treat these as not played under the Rules of Golf and post according to "par plus" any handicap strokes the player is entitled to receive.

(For more information, see Section 4-2).

Note: If a player plays nearly all holes accompanied but just a few alone, the holes played alone are calculated using "par plus," keeping in mind the maximum that can be played alone in a

round eligible for posting is two holes for a nine-hole score and five holes for an 18-hole score. Some examples would be starting out alone and joining up with a player(s), or starting out accompanied and finishing the round alone.

Golf:

Thursday May 19- Skins game at Laughlin Ranch with a shotgun start at 12:00. Cost is \$80 which includes green fees, cart, net and gross skins (please pay in advance separately from the fee list on application).

Friday May 20 - Gross and Net Skins Game (two flights) with closest to pin at Mojave- Shotgun start at 8:00.

Saturday May 21- Tournament at Los Lagos paying approximately 30% of the field for low net with gross skins/closest– **2 or 3** flights depending on entries. Shotgun start at 8:00.

Socializing

- Awards Ceremony 6:00-7:30PM Saturday at the Edgewater Hotel & Casino with a full buffet dinner (fish, chicken, and beef) and a no host bar.
- Entertainment / camaraderie–must see to believe.

Lodging

Edgewater Hotel/ Casino with a 3PM check in time.

Payment

- The prices on the entry form include everything required: hotel, golf, cart, range balls, prize money, and the socializing mentioned above.
- The entry form with money attached is requested by Mar 31 with final deadline Apr 15. Will not commit Men's Club money for people who have not paid (you are not in until I have your entry fee in hand).
- Guests are welcome and male guests are eligible to cash (with established handicap) gross skins and closest. Subtract \$40 from price list on entry form for guest and call me for a price if female golfer playing).

Prize Money

Other than rooms and golf, the major expense is the awards ceremony/ buffet —please check "no" on the entry form if you do not plan to attend because I have to pay in advance. No cost for significant other for Awards Ceremony but \$30 for each additional guest. The Edgewater is the host hotel (better rates) - encourage socializing and fun there but you have the option to make your own hotel reservations. After room, golf, and awards ceremony costs, the remainder of the entry fee goes into prize money and allows for substantial payoffs in each flight and very sizeable skins pots. For the Thursday skins game, \$59 goes to green fees and \$10.50 into gross and \$10.50 into net skins pot.
