

# Everything you need to know about your upcoming trip to camp!

# **Getting to Camp:**

#### **Directions:**

From the 15, take The 76 east to S6 (windy, shorter) OR S7 (straighter, longer) to the top of Palomar Mountain. Then take State Park Road (Turn left on the road that is just before the General Store.) Go through the State Park (no need to pay the \$8.00 fee) and follow the signs to camp. Our driveway is about 2 miles into the park to the left (The next road after you pass Cedar Grove Campground)

**DO NOT TAKE NATE HARRISON ROAD!** It's a fire road that turns to rough gravel halfway to camp and has deep potholes and sharp curves.

There are no gas stations on the mountain, so make sure you are filled up (half a tank or more) before coming to camp.

### **Packing List:**

Clothing Toiletries

Closed-toe shoes Bible/pen/journal

Pants/jeans cold weather clothing (55° or less)

Pillow Bedding (twin bunks)

Towel

1-piece bathing suit and beach towel (June-August)

All buildings have heat; motel style housing also has A/C Stella Wright Cottage and Spruce Lodge does include bedding and towels.

# Things to Know:

Rooms will be ready for check-in at 4:00pm on first day of camp.

Check-out time for housing is **9:00am** on last day of camp. Please ensure all items are removed from room by this time.

Personal cars are not allowed into main camp. Please park in lower parking lot and walk luggage to your rooms. Luggage carts are available in parking lot.

Coffee/tea/drinking water is available in your meeting room 24/7! Coffee is easy to brew, follow directions located by coffee maker. *Note: Fireside, Ponderosa and Redwood meeting rooms have beverages delivered twice a day- no self-brewing in these rooms.* 

#### **Emergency Procedures:**

Please report to Ballfield if you hear long continuous siren/bell. We will give emergency instructions from there.

If an emergency occurs in night, please contact your group leader.

Payphone is located in front of Office for 911 calls. Contact PCCC staff by radio if Office is closed. Radio is located in metal box past Gift Shop door.

#### **PCCC Rules:**

Shoes/Sandals must be worn when outdoors.

Only painters tape or masking tape allowed on walls.

Inside furniture cannot be moved outdoors.

No food or drink in housing area (meeting rooms okay).

Smoking only allowed behind dining hall/parking lot.

**Girls**: Only 1 piece bathing suits/modest tankinis allowed at pool (dark colored t-shirt can be worn over two-piece suit).

Boys: Only trunk-style swim shorts

### **Things not allowed at PCCC:**

Illegal drugs

Alcoholic beverages

Cohabitation

Pets

Skateboards, bicycles or other wheeled toys

AT&T is the only cell phone company that has coverage at camp. PCCC staff does not give out WI-FI pass code; ask your group leader for pass code if you need to use WI-FI.

There is no ATM at camp. You are able to pay with card in Office for activities if you do not have cash. No cash back.

#### **Dining Hall Procedures:**

- 1. Enter through East doors. Doors will be unlocked at meal time.
- 2. Food is served buffet style. Use new plate each time through line.
- 3. Take used dishes to dish return counter before you depart.

#### **Food Allergies:**

If you have food allergies or dietary special needs please inform your group leader **1** week prior to camp. During meals at camp, please check-in at kitchen window in Dining Hall for your food needs.

## **Camp Activities:**

Activities are typically scheduled for the afternoons of full camp days. Seek your group leader for specific details about your retreat activities.

**Horse Trail Rides sign-ups** open at 8:00am in Office the day of ride. Sign up by11:00am for your spot. Come early as space is filled quickly.

Ages 9+. Price: \$25. Must weigh less than 250 lbs; closed-toed shoes and long pants required.

First Come- First play; Pay for activities on site

Archery: All ages. Price: Free

**Zipline**: All ages. Price: \$4.00 a ride/\$10 unlimited

High Ropes: Ages 13+. Price: \$5

Swimming Pool: All ages. Price: Free, Available June-August

Gun Range:

BB Guns: All ages. Price: Free

Target with .22s: Ages 11+. Price: 10 shots for \$3

Skeet with Shotguns: Ages 12+. Price: 3 Shots for \$2

You can bring your own guns/ammo to Gun Range. Only 12 and 20 gauge shotguns and .22 rifles. **No pistols or automatic rifles allowed**. Semi-automatic are okay.

All guns must be locked and stored in car trunks before and after use, carried in case to range.

**Clay Pigeons** can be purchased by the case: 135 pigeons is \$12.00 (applied only to those bringing own guns)
