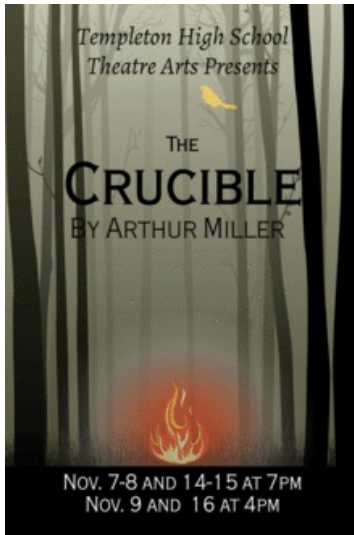

Themes of betrayal and revenge, love and redemption, and the devastatingly destructive power of fear and perverted justice are evoked in this powerful and deeply moving drama.

passenger train in the new town of Templeton on November 20, 1886. For three years, Templeton was the “end of the line” for trains as the Southern Pacific extended the railroad from San Francisco to Los Angeles. And during that time, the little town became a thriving community.

Everyone is invited to join the Templeton Historical Museum Society in celebrating that historic date. Those in attendance will hear short lectures on various aspects of Templeton’s history, tour the museum buildings, see a live demonstration by a blacksmith, and weather permitting, take a guided walking tour to discover historic buildings in Templeton.

Highlights include the official dedication of the Museum’s fully restored 1932 Templeton School Bus at 11:30 am, and of course, FREE pie and cake will be served until supplies run out!

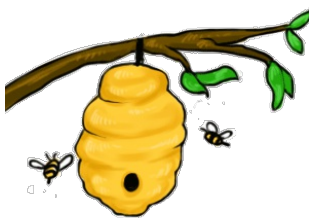
