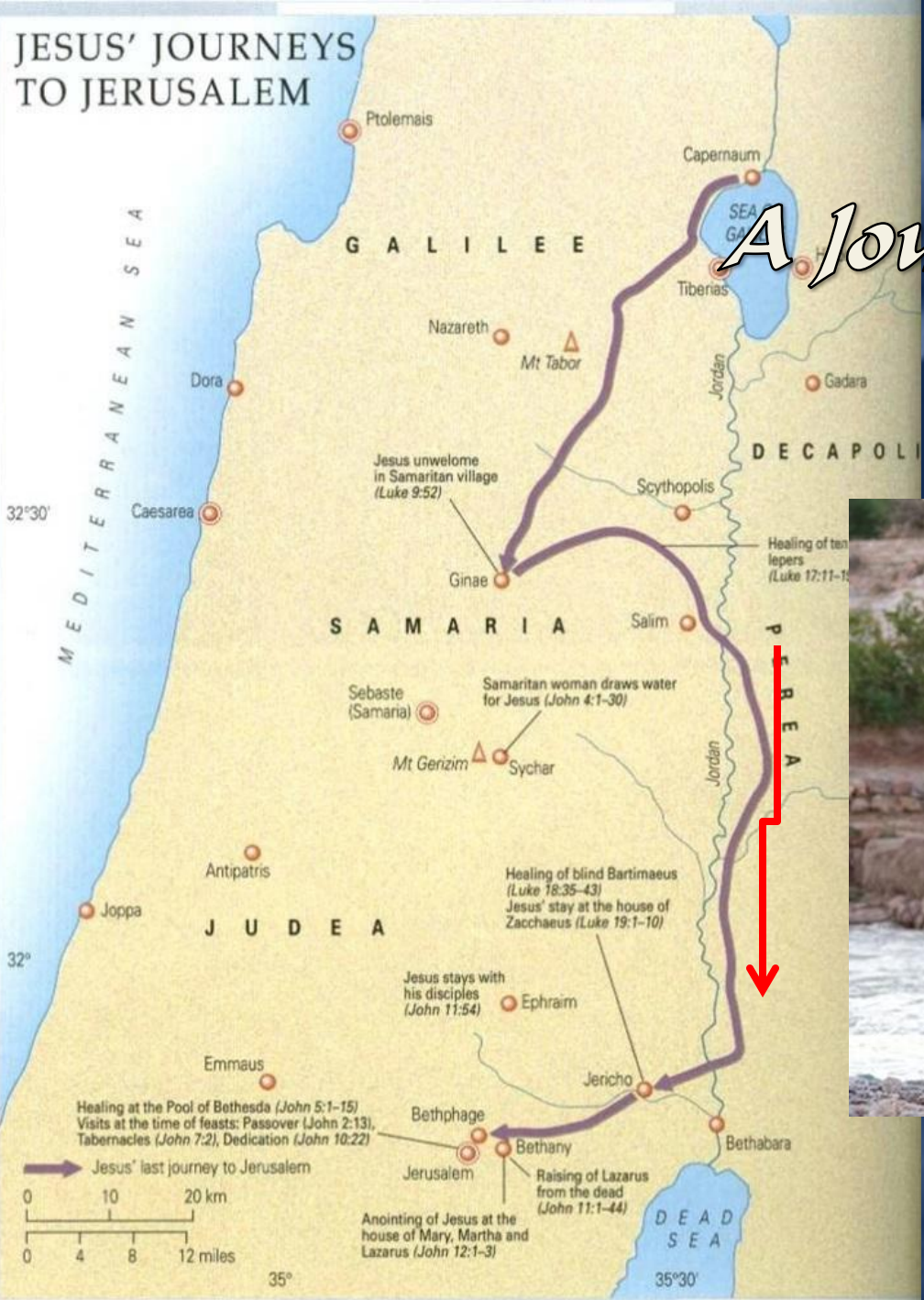

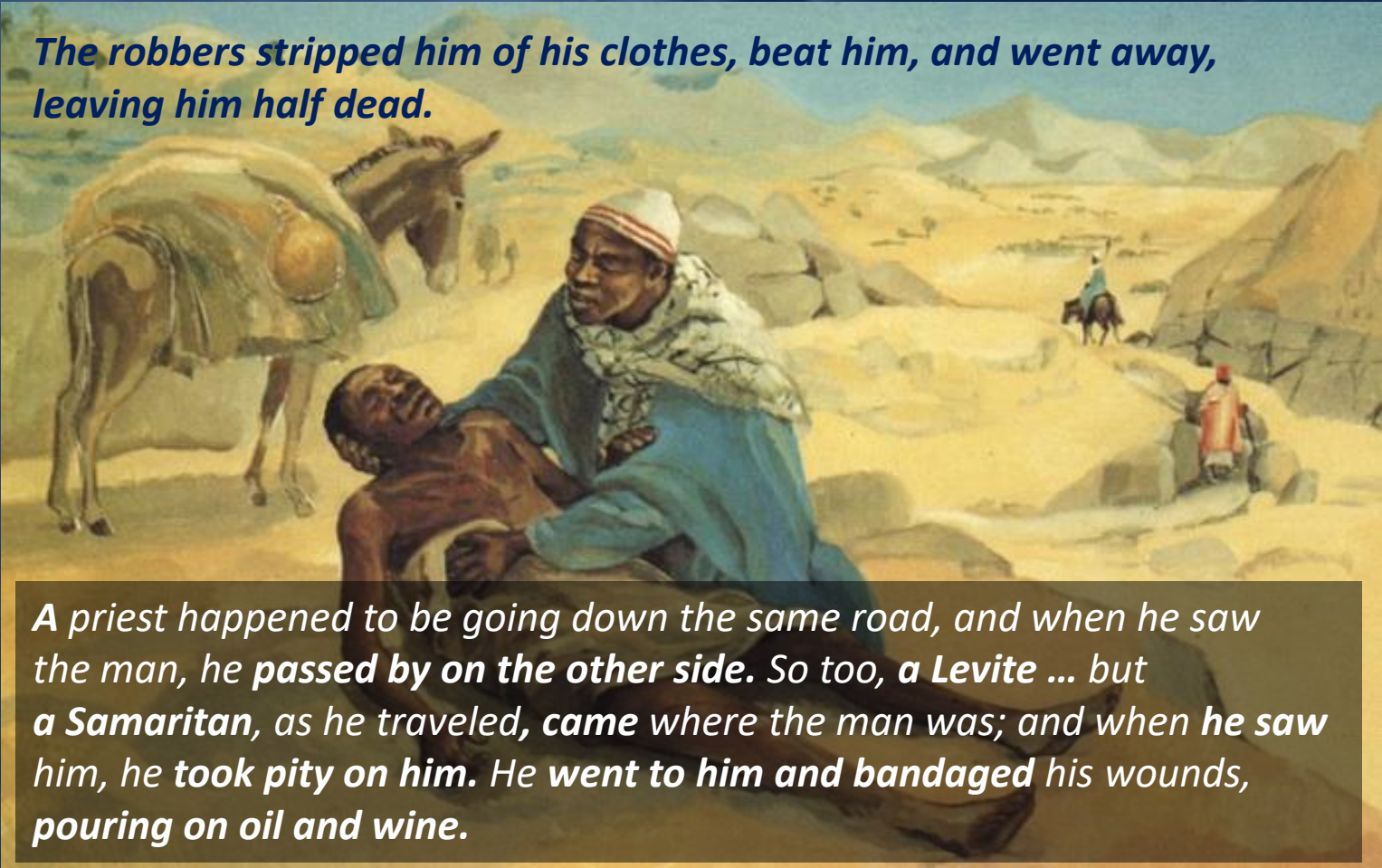

The robbers stripped him of his clothes, beat him, and went away, leaving him half dead.

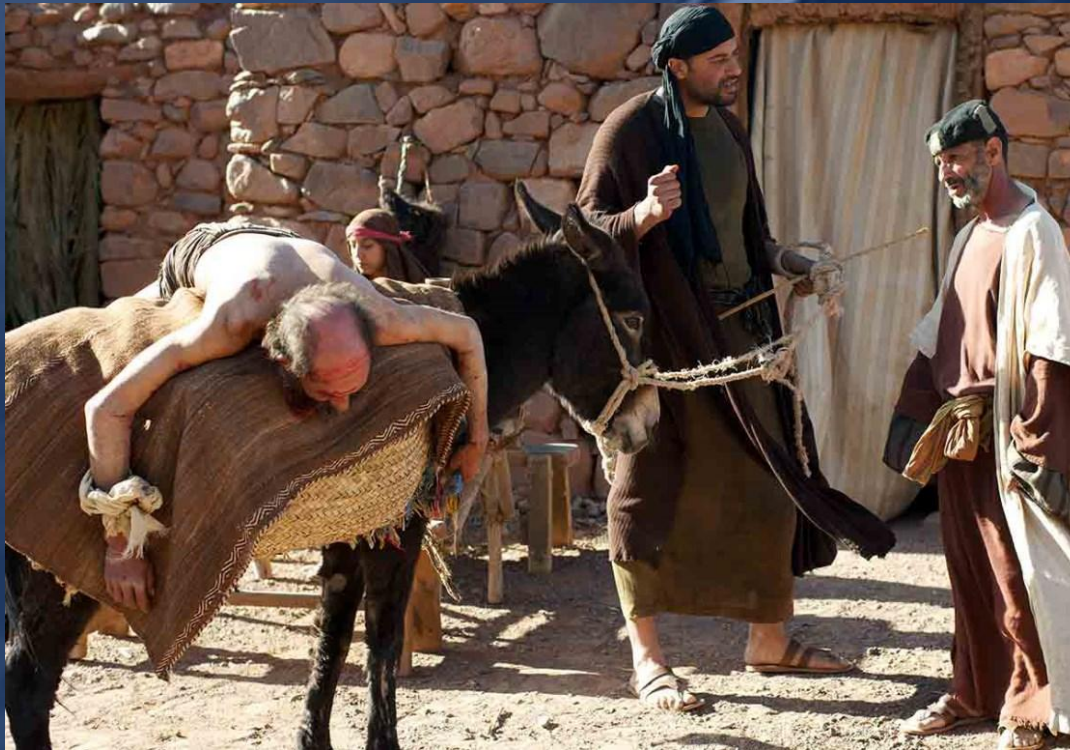

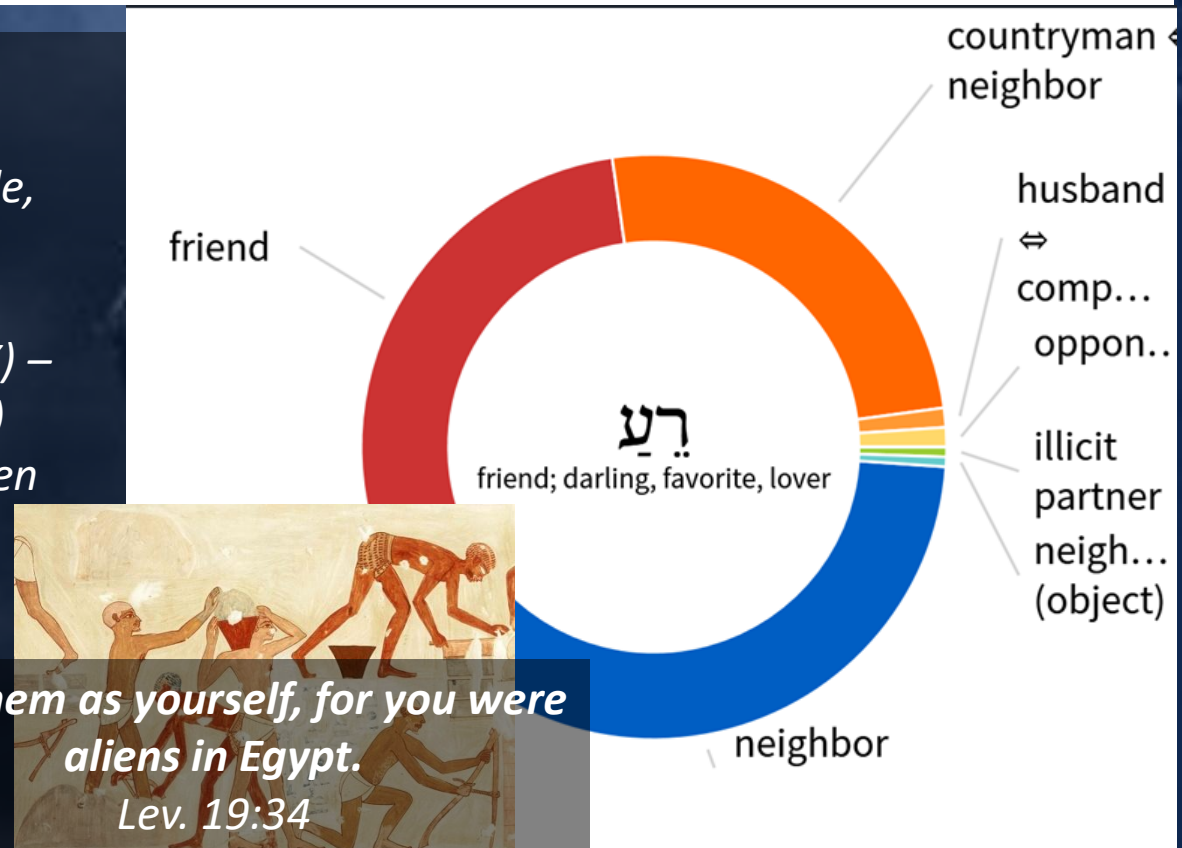
Figure 1. The senses of רֵעַ in the Old Testament (Tanakh) generated with Logos Bible Software


