- 5:15am Arrive at San Francisco International Airport (SFO) for your flight via your own transportation.
Upon arrival, check-in to your flight and move through security on to your departure gate.
- 7:45am Depart California for New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) on Delta flight DL1673.
- 4:20pm Arrive into New York City!

Situated in the Midtown area of Manhattan, the festival hotel is within easy walking distance to Times Square, Central Park, Rockefeller Center, and some of the most amazing restaurants and shopping known on the planet! The Midtown area includes the Theatre District, the Diamond District, the Garment District, and major television studios.

Continue on to baggage claim and collect your luggage.
A World Projects Festival Staff Member will meet you in baggage claim and assist with loading the coach.
Depart for the Sheraton New York Times Square Hotel.

Upon arrival, check-in to your rooms.

Hotel check-in is at 4:00pm, however all rooms may not be available upon arrival. Thank you for your patience.

The rest of the evening is free to explore the city on own.

- Evening Enjoy dinner on own (or can be arranged by World Projects at an additional cost).
The rest of the evening is free.

**DAY TWO: Sunday, June 12, 2022 – NEW YORK CITY – Workshop**

- Morning Enjoy breakfast on own (or can be arranged through World Projects at an additional cost).
This morning, enjoy a 60-minute group **workshop** with a Festival clinician!
Afterwards, return your instruments to your rooms.
- Afternoon Enjoy lunch on own in the area.
This day is free for sightseeing on own.

This afternoon may be the best opportunity to see a Broadway show, or enjoy the exhibits of world class museums such as the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the American Museum of Natural History, or the Guggenheim. (All additional costs on own or can be arranged through World Projects.)

- Evening Enjoy dinner on own (or can be arranged through World Projects at an additional cost).
The rest of the evening is free.



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**DAY THREE: Monday, June 13, 2022 – NEW YORK CITY (D) – Outdoor Performance**

- Morning** Enjoy breakfast on own (*or can be arranged through World Projects at an additional cost*).
After breakfast, load the coach with instruments and depart for a nearby venue (*possibly Brooklyn Bridge Park, Battery Park, or similar – TBC*).
Upon arrival, enjoy your **outdoor “pops-style” performance!**
- Afternoon** Afterwards, enjoy lunch on own nearby.
After lunch, load the coach and return to the hotel.
The rest of the afternoon is free for sightseeing on own!
- ~5:30pm** Later, assemble in the hotel’s lobby dressed for this evening’s activity.
- ~5:45pm** Load the coach and depart for Chelsea Piers for the Festival Dinner Cruise.
- 7:00-9:30pm** Enjoy the Festival Dinner / DJ Dance Cruise! Eat, dance to DJ music, and enjoy the sights on the Festival Dinner Cruise (including a stunning view of the Statue of Liberty) as you cruise along the Hudson River with other Festival participants.
- ~9:30pm** Following the cruise, return to the hotel.

**DAY FOUR: Tuesday, June 14, 2022 – NEW YORK CITY – Carnegie Hall Performance**

- Morning** Enjoy breakfast on own (*or can be arranged through World Projects at an additional cost*).
This morning is free for sightseeing and shopping on own.
- Afternoon** Enjoy lunch on your own.
Time TBD Later, meet in the lobby of the hotel in performance attire with instruments.
You will be escorted to Carnegie Hall on foot by a World Projects Festival Staff Member.
Arrive at Carnegie Hall for your 30-minute sound check and group photo on stage.
Following your sound check, store instruments in your warm-up room.
- Evening** Enjoy dinner on own nearby (*or can be arranged through World Projects at an additional cost*).
- ~7:30pm** Later, return to Carnegie Hall for your **performance** as part of the **Evening Concert** in the Isaac Stern Auditorium / Ronald O. Perelman Stage at Carnegie Hall!
Following the concert is the Awards Ceremony. All directors will be asked to join the Master of Ceremonies on stage for a short Awards Ceremony.
After the concert, return to the hotel on foot.



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DAY FIVE: Wednesday, June 15, 2022 – NEW YORK CITY DEPARTURE

- Morning** Enjoy breakfast on own (*or can be arranged through World Projects at an additional cost*).
This morning is free for last-minute shopping and sightseeing and may be the best opportunity for exploring beyond Midtown to visit sites such as the Statue of Liberty, Ellis Island, and the 9/11 Memorial.
- By 12:00pm** Check-out of the hotel and store your luggage in a designated area.
Load the coach and depart for New York’s John F. Kennedy International Airport.
- By 4:45pm** Upon arrival, check-in to your flight and move through security and on to your departure gate.
- 7:15pm** Depart New York City for San Francisco International Airport (SFO) on Delta flight DL 1659.
- 10:50pm** Arrive into San Francisco. Continue on to baggage claim and collect your luggage.
Depart for home via your own transportation.

NOTES:

- ♦ **Payment / Group Billing:** All fees are in US Dollars. Accepted forms of payment are organization check, cashier's check, money order, and wire transfer. Credit cards and/or individual payments will not be accepted.
- ♦ **Airfare:** ACTUAL roundtrip airfare has been included in the above costs. Sixty (60) seats have been deposited on. One (1) gratis air ticket for every 20 paid participants is included. Only the base fare is guaranteed. Taxes and surcharges are subject to change until ticketing. Should additional taxes or surcharges be levied, World Projects retains the right to pass on all such surcharges to Johansen High School.
- ♦ **Air Baggage Fees:** Baggage fees are set by the individual airlines and are subject to change. Delta Airlines currently charges \$30 one-way for the first checked bag up to 50 lbs and 62 linear inches, and \$40 one-way for the second checked bag up to 50 lbs and 62 linear inches. Additional fees will apply for overweight / oversize baggage / instruments. World Projects has included a fund of \$60 roundtrip per person for first checked baggage and a fund of \$2,000 towards second checked, oversized, and overweight baggage fees. Johansen High School will be responsible for all baggage fees exceeding these amounts at airport check-in.
- ♦ **Accommodations:** Quad denotes four (4) people per room, two beds per room. Triple denotes three (3) people per room, two beds per room. Sharing beds for quad and triple occupancy will be necessary. Double occupancy rooms could have two beds or one bed in the room. Single occupancy rooms will have one bed.
- ♦ **Availability / Ground Costs:** This quote is based on 2022 pricing and is subject to availability at the time of booking.
- ♦ **Gratis:** Gratis is based on the double occupancy price.
- ♦ **Travel Protection Plan:** World Projects will purchase a Student/Group Protection Plan (post departure) for all travelers of US-based groups (within the 50 states). Details of the plan will be sent to the group leader.
- ♦ **Required Forms:** All travelers will be required to submit signed liability waivers and medical authorizations forms as issued by World Projects to participate in the festival/tour.
- ♦ **Numbers:** Please note that the New York "Sounds of Summer" Festival requires a minimum of 60 travelers for the group. This minimum may be reached by including all travelers (i.e. performers, staff, and chaperones/adults). World Projects reserves the right to re-cost the festival package should the numbers fall below the stated minimum above.
- ♦ **Agreement:** World Projects will require the group leader to sign a Performance Agreement which will outline terms and conditions including festival/tour costs, inclusions/exclusions, and the payment/cancellation schedule.
