DETAILS

Big Valley Ranch comes equipped with tent sites and RV/trailer sites with or without power hook ups, 24X24 permanent outdoor pens for housing animals (trailers with panels can also be used if inclement weather), a picnic pavilion, shower/bathroom facilities, and access to 50+ miles of groomed trails. They also provide rental of a bunkhouse with beds for 6 for an additional fee (2 night rental minimum).

Midwest Llama and Iowa Llama will be paying for a portion of the campsite fees, pen rentals, and all the food (just bring your own beverages for the weekend and a side dish to pass for Friday night) for members of either or both organizations. COSTS

If you are a member of Midwest Llama Association and/or Iowa Llama Association, the association(s) will cover:

- \$15 of the \$20 (for non-electric spaces) or \$30 (for electric spaces) for camping
- \$5 of the \$10 for each 24X24 pens
- \$5 of the \$10 for the attendance fee for each person over 5 years old (under 5 is free)

For example: a family of four (all over 5 years old) renting a non-electric space and two 24X24 pens would pay \$35 for the camping trip if they are members of one or both associations, or \$80 if they are not members of either association.

All meals are included in the attendance cost except beverages for the trip and a side dish to pass for the Friday night pot luck. There is a pavilion to plug in crock pots, roasters, etc., but there is no refrigeration available.
