August is Heat Stroke Awareness Month

Heat stroke is the most serious heat related illness. When the body is unable to control its temperature, it rises rapidly and sweating mechanisms fail. Body temperature may rise to 106 degrees or higher within 10-15 minutes. Heat stroke can cause death or permanent disability if emergency treatment is not provided.

Signs of heat stroke

*High body temperature (above 103 degrees).

*Red, hot, dry skin (no sweating)

*Rapid, strong pulse

*Throbbing headache

*Dizziness, nausea, confusion

*Unconsciousness

These are the signs of a life threatening emergency. Have someone call 911 while you begin cooling the person:

*Get them to a shady area.

*Cool them rapidly, however you can: Immerse them in a cool tub of water or shower; spray them with cool water from a garden hose; sponge them with cool water; wrap them in a cool, wet sheet and fan them vigorously.

*Monitor body temperature; continue cooling efforts until body temperature drops to 101-102 degrees.

*If they are conscious and able to swallow, give cool water or nonalcoholic, decaffeinated beverages.


