October 10, 2018 was no ordinary day for the southwest Georgia town of Donalsonville and her 2,700 residents. Hurricane Michael made landfall at Mexico Beach, Florida and headed straight for Donalsonville. They took a direct hit. Much of the town was reduced to a broken mess of rubble, splintered trees and thrashed crops. Every home, farm and business was affected, some with total destruction.

Eclectic-area churches, businesses and individuals want to help this sister town get back on her feet. Our goal is to raise \$25,000 but we believe we can exceed that through the generosity of our loving community. **One hundred percent** of funds raised will be given directly to the families that were hit hardest by this brutal storm.

We are working closely with Donalsonville pastors, first responders and civic servants to identify families in serious need. Eclectic community leaders and volunteers will deliver the contributions to Donalsonville in mid-December, just before Christmas.
