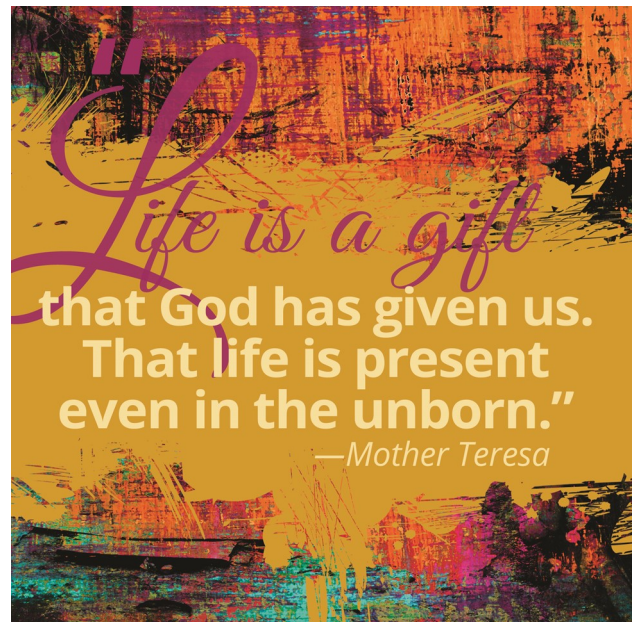
OCS Parish Sponsorship
