

49<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Roe v Wade

The anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision is on January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. It will be 49 years since the U.S. Supreme Court decision. Legalized abortion still grips our nation. In December Dobbs vs Jackson Women's Health Case presented in the Supreme Court. This case challenges the legality of abortions in a way that could overrule Roe v. Wade. Let us especially pray for the results of this case and that life will be upheld from conception to natural death throughout our nation and world. Results of Dobbs vs. Jackson should be announced in June 2022.


#### **OCS Parish Sponsorship**
