Trustee Mann seconded the motion, and the roll was called on the question of its adoption.



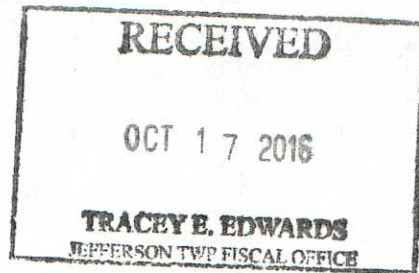


