Requirements are as follows:

2. Business Administration.
3. Natural Sciences, (chemistry, biology, physics, earth science, bio-chemistry, or engineering.

Submit a one page typed essay (300 words or less); communicate why you should be awarded this scholarship.

Submit at least 2 letters of recommendations from your high school staff members written in your behalf.
