If you are planning on visiting TX in the hunting season of 2023, there are some things you should know before you go. The TX Parks and Wildlife Department has released its hunting season dates for the latest season.

In TX, hunters are required to check their tags every year. However, the number of hunters checking their tags has decreased due to new technology like GPS-enabled locators and deer monitoring applications. Backcountry hunters who don't use GPS locators now have the opportunity to venture out and hunt for a whole season without getting tagged, thanks to this "reduced check" option.

Over 1 million acres of wildlife land in TX, including TPWD-owned property, land leased from other state and government agencies, forest products companies, and land that individual owners support. The Annual Public Hunting Permit enables year-round hunting for white-tailed deer, wild pigs, doves, quail, turkey, birds, rabbit, fox, and more on nearly one million acres. For excellent native animals and foreign species on TPWDmanaged areas and specifically leased private lands, drawn hunts are available. For novice hunters, TPWD and associate organizations provide managed hunting workshops and routine (Daily) Permit Hunts for small game and wildlife. They include supervised, drawn hunts for adult and youth shooters, E-Postcard selection hunts, and special hunt package drawings.



In Beaumont, Texas, a homeowner shot and wounded a man who reportedly had broken into his house in the middle of the night on May 19. Responding police saved the 43-year-old intruder's life by using a tourniquet to stop his bleeding and transported him to the hospital; he was to be charged with burglary upon release and held on a \$100,000 bond. The Beaumont Police spokesperson emphasized that the homeowner would face no charges: "The suspect is the one who broke the law and committed a crime, and as a result, he was shot." Bidenomics: Bill Would Add \$5,000 Federal Tax to \$500 AR-15

Democrats in Congress last week quietly introduced a plan to prohibitively tax ownership of popular semi-auto firearms and magazines.

U.S. Rep. Don "Doug" Beyer, a Democrat from Virginia, allied with 24 partisan cosponsors largely hailing from blue states, introduced H.R.5135 on Aug. 4. While the text of the proposal isn't available, the title "To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to impose an additional 1,000 percent excise tax on the sale of large capacity ammunition feeding devices and semiautomatic assault weapons, and for other purposes," leaves little to the imagination.

Such a move would bump the base price of an entry-model AR, such as a Diamondback DB15, Ruger AR556, or S&W M&P15, from about \$650 to \$7,150 – a figure that would still be subject to state and local taxes. More top-shelf models would have a price that approaches \$20,000. Likewise, the price of a basic magazine such as a Magpul PMAG would jump from \$14 to over \$150.

Beyer introduced a similar bill last session, his "Assault Weapons Excise Act," which had 41 co-sponsors, all Democrats.

Federal background checks for over-the-counter gun sales passed a big milestone last month, chalking up four solid years of consecutive seven-digit figures.

The National Shooting Sports Foundation confirmed the 48-month streak after calculating the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Instant Criminal Background Check System figures for July 2023.

The unadjusted FBI NICS total for last month stands at 1,987,650. Once the data is analyzed by NSSF to remove checks and rechecks processed for carry permits and other reasons, the number of checks for likely retail gun sales remains at 1,023,903, standing at the sixth highest seen in the month of July going back for the NICS program's 24-year history.

The big takeaway pointed out by NSSF is an ongoing monthly 1 million adjusted background check threshold that has held firm since July 2019.


