Gospel: Luke 23:35-43. "The Shepherd King"

Jesus is a king like no other. His rule is not the power of force but the force of Love. And it is important for us to remember that the cross does not belong to Him alone. It is the legacy and the inheritance that He has promised to all those who follow Him. He has come not to put an end to human suffering, but to show mankind how to suffer and to understand why we suffer.

Maybe that's why we end our church year with this feast. The feast of Christ the King precedes the Season of Advent and affirms what Advent is all about. Christ has come and is present in our world - the Word made Flesh, the Bread of Life. We prepare for the Season of Advent by remembering that our God chose to become a human being just like us.
