To the Sherburn and Welcome City Council,

The department responded to 226 calls for service in the month of February. This brings the total for the year to 491. By comparison, the department responded to 358 calls in 2018 and 369 calls in 2017 for the same reporting period.

Response time average for the department was 3 minutes, 30 seconds. This is about average for the department.

The department web-site had 1,817 visits in the month of February. The average is 2,411.

We dealt with a large number of snow events over the last several weeks. We had a number of stranded vehicles, vehicles of the road and numerous other weather related events. I think everyone is anxious for warmer dryer weather and hopefully we will see that for the remainder of March.

We will begin the city clean up inspections as soon as the snow has gone down enough to allow us to make the tour.
