MARCH FESTIVALS AND FAIRS IN FLORIDA

Florida Strawberry Festival, Plant City, March 3-13, 2022 Like a state fair, the Strawberry Festival has agricultural displays, livestock shows, arts and crafts, local food and a huge carnival midway. <u>Gasparilla Festival of the Arts</u>, Tampa, March 5-6, 2022 This large festival offers top prize money that attracts 320+ top fine artists.

<u>Grant Seafood Festival</u>, Grant-Sebastian, March 5-6, 2022 The Grant Seafood Festival is put on by volunteers and has been held every year since 1966 in this sprawling riverside community between Melbourne and Sebastian.

Fort Myers Beach Shrimp Festival, Fort Myers Beach, March 12-13, 2022

There are still working fishing boats in this town pulling in shrimp from the Gulf and that's the reason Fort Myers Beach has held its shrimp festival for 50 years

<u>Bike Week</u>, Daytona Beach, March 4-13, 2022 For 78 years, motorcyclists have gathered in Daytona Beach for a spring fling and this year, they're expecting a half million. <u>Marathon Seafood Festival</u>, Marathon, March 12-13, 2022 The Key's most popular seafood fest is the "original" in Marathon.

Calle Ocho Festival, Miami, March 13, 2022

This street festival is enormous: It attracts a million people to the largest Hispanic festival in the United States. The event stretches for 20 blocks with 10 stages and it has everything: food, music, art and a giant conga line. Calle Ocho is part of the larger <u>Carnaval Miami</u>.

Winter Park Sidewalk Art Festival, Winter Park, March 18-20, 2022 This large show annually earns top ranking among art festivals nationwide. In addition to the draw of high-quality art, it is located in a beautiful and historic community with big shade trees and activities to entertain various ages and interests.

Sunnyland Boat Festival, Tavares, March 24-27, 2022 This antique and classic boat festival is one of the largest classic wood boat shows in the country with as many as 250 to 300 restored boats on display in the water and along one third of a mile of Lake Dora shoreline at Wooton Park in Tavares.

St. Augustine Lions Spring Festival, St. Augustine, March 26-27, 2022.

The St. Augustine Lions Club seafood festival has changed its name in 2022 to the Lions Spring Festival after cancelling it in 2021 due to COVID.
