

For Christians, the source of all love is God, expressed in the gift of His Son on Christmas Day. 1 John 4:19-21 sets the stage for how we are to view love. "We love because He first loved us. ## Quilting Day 3:00 pm Sunday, Feb. 23


Come join us on Sunday, February 23rd at 3:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall for quilting fun.
