

We expect to spend 3 hours at the Fair, then board the bus for a short trip to Franklin Park Conservatory and Botanical Gardens.

Be prepared to be amazed! Stroll through the conservatory and interact with a 46' long ecosystem projected on the gallery walls. The Pacific Island Water Garden is a tropical haven filled with bright nectar blooms where hundreds of butterflies fly freely. More butterflies are released at 3:00 PM daily.

It will be open to the public from noon to 4:00 PM, with no admission charge and free parking.

All *amateur growers* are invited to exhibit in the Horticulture Division. <u>All horticulture must be placed on Friday, July 13</u> from noon to 4:00 PM, but original specimens may be replaced by fresh specimens on Saturday, July 14, from 8:30-9:30 AM.

Exhibiting in the Design Division and the educational Special Exhibits Division requires pre-show registration (phone the Garden Center—724-837-0245): set-up on Friday, July 13, noon to 4:00 PM and Saturday, July 14, 8:30-9:30 AM.

All exhibits will be evaluated by National Garden Club, Inc. accredited Flower Show Judges, who will place Blue, Red, Yellow and White ribbons, as merited. Blue ribbon winners are eligible for NA-TIONAL GARDEN CLUBS, INC. Top Flower Show Awards.

Residents of REDSTONE have been invited to participate in one Class of the Design Division, eligible for a Special Award from the Flower Show Committee.

The Flower Show Chairman is Angie Raitano, of Valley Garden Club, and Co-Vice-Chairmen are Mary Ann Artman and Margie Wolff, both active members of Murrysville Garden Club.

Flower Shows are educational and always **FUN**. Everyone is invited to participate and attend the show.
