

AUDITION Information for Disney's The Little Mermaid Jr.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

Auditioners are required to come prepared to sing a one minute audition song. Any song is fine as long as it shows off your voice. You may sing to a CD, (we provide the playing device), you may also sing acapella or bring your own device, (ie, I-Phone, I-Pad, etc.) NO AUDITION APPOINTMENTS WILL BE TAKEN. Show up ANYTIME between 5 and 8 p.m. on the date listed on the AUDITION page of our web site. Be sure to bring a parent along so they can list all the conflicts you will have during September and October

WHEN ARE THE REHEARSALS?

Rehearsals will be 3 to 4 days a week. The week the show opens rehearsals will go until 8:00 p.m. [Rehearsals will be held in The San Marcos Community Center and the show will perform there as well.](#)

TENTATIVE REHEARSAL DATES:

September 12 - Parent meeting.....4:30 to 6:30

October 1, 3, 8, 10, 12, 15, 17, 18, 19.....4:30 to 7:00
October 21 (Sunday), 2 to 6 p.m. (I pay for this day)
October 22, 23, 24 - 4 to 8 p.m.

PLAYING DATES: Friday, Oct. 26- 7:30 show / Saturday, Oct. 27 - 3:00 p.m. / Sunday, Oct. 28 - 6:00 p.m.

Some rehearsal dates and time may change once casting is done and REMEMBER: If you have conflicts with any of the rehearsal dates list them on the audition form when you get to the auditions. If you are thinking you have too many conflicts and you THINK you shouldn't audition...AUDITION ANYWAY. You may not be called to all the rehearsals you have conflicts for. Let the Director decide. The only way you would NOT BE CAST, (DUE TO CONFLICTS), is if you have conflicts with PLAYING DATES.

HOW MANY CHILDREN WILL BE CAST and do I need PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE?

No previous experience is necessary. We try our very best to cast every child that auditions. Total cast size can be as high as 50 and as low as 35. We know how hard it is - especially for the beginners - to get up in front of someone and sing. If your child does not get in the show it is because of conflicts with the final schedule; behavioral issues from previous shows; or if your child only wants a specific part and the Director does not seem them in the role they want
