Community Scholarship

The Antioch Garden Club (AGC) is an organization that serves the Antioch, Illinois community through charitable and philanthropic activities. It promotes conservation, beautification of our community, and intellectual development and sociability among its members.

Purpose of the Scholarship Programs:

AGC is proud of its scholarship program, which offers financial aid to students and adults and promotes study in Horticulture, Floriculture, Landscape Design, Botany, Plant Pathology, Forestry, Agronomy, Environmental Concerns, City Planning, Land Management and/or allied subjects. Applicants must be majoring in one of these fields of study. The Community Scholarship Award will be \$1,000.00

Eligibility:

Open to any person who resides in Antioch Township or neighboring communities. Must be currently enrolled at a 2-or 4-year college or university OR must be a current high school senior or a returning adult student who intends on enrolling at a 2- or 4-year college, university or accredited technical school.

Application Process:

Complete the following application according to the directions provided. Include one letter or recommendation from a source other than a relative, who can describe your character.

Complete a personal statement essay (500 words or less) discussing your background, future goals and commitment to chosen career. The essay must be typed, or computer generated using 12-point double spaced type.

Attach an official transcript from the school you most recently attended. Do not include any materials other than those requested.

All of the materials are to be assembled and mailed as a complete packet to the AGC Scholarship Chairperson. All applications must be received April 30, 2020.

Selection Process:

Applications must be received no later than the deadline date. Applications received after that date will NOT be considered.

Applications must include all required information.

Any reference to the applicant's name will be deleted prior to the selection committee reviewing individual applications.

The selection process will be completed by a committee of AGC members.

Strong consideration will be given to the level of volunteerism, activities, and community service involvement.

All applicants will be notified of their status regarding the final selection.

The selected candidate will be asked to attend the AGC meeting on the evening of the first Monday in June to be presented the scholarship award.
