Leon John Rosinski, 95, of Bad Axe, died Friday, Sept. 27, 2002, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe. He was born March 14, 1907 in Tyre, son of the late Andrew and Antonia (Warczyk) Rosinski. Leon married Mary on Dec. 29, 1934 in Detroit. After training in Chicago to be an electrician, Mr. Rosinski worked for the Briggs Motor Car Co. in Detroit which was later bought by Chrysler Corp. He remained with Chrysler for 43 years.
