



Oak Wilt

Oak Wilt is a disease caused by a fungus called Ceratocystis fagacearum.

Causes a clogging of the water conducting vessels of infected oak trees, causing the trees to wilt and die.

Symptoms





Veinal necrosis is an important symptom of the disease in Live Oaks.
