- Place gifts where they can't be seen from the outside.
- Avoid opening the door to strangers.
 Delivery people will be able to show photo identification.
- Investigate charities before donating by calling the charity's main office or checking online.
- Be sure to mail cards with money, checks or gift certificates from the Post Office or a blue US Postal Service collection box.
- If traveling, use timers for lights and radios while you're away. Ask a trusted friend or neighbor to watch your home. Remember to make arrangements for mail and newspapers.

Certainly, distributing 9,500 bags to 415 homes in a short period of time is a big job and we are thankful for our volunteers. Without their hard work and dedication our "luminaria" tradition would surely fail.

We were all blessed 34 years ago when Paula and Doug Kerley brought this beautiful tradition to our Grove Park community. Joan and Roger Painter continued this tradition for 7 of those years. The tradition was carried on for the remaining 26 years by Roger and Sandy Willi, who continued faithfully and tirelessly to ensure that Grove Park was lit up every year on Christmas Eve.



We owe the Willi's a debt of gratitude for all that they have done, and they graciously are holding our hand as we work to take this over in our 34th year.

The sand will be in the usual place, on the right-hand side of Catalina Road West toward the sewer transfer station near the corner of Holiday Road South.

- Sand delivery is scheduled on, or before December 15th. Also, we request when you are picking up your sand to please be respectful of the lawns of the houses on either side of the street.
- The bags will be given to the volunteers within the first week of December and will be delivered in the following weeks.
- It is your responsibility to provide the candles for your bags. Almost any type candle will do, but we have found that the "votive" candles in glass holders work well and last a long time. They are available in Walmart packaged 12 to a box. You will need anywhere from 18 to 36 candles depending upon the size of your lot. Should you need more bags, please give us a call at the number listed below.

As usual a donation box will be located at the sand pile for those of you wishing to make a contribution to help offset the cost of the bags and the sand.
