



Library Update



Happy New Year again from Giles County Public Library! This past year has been a good one with lots of fun, educational and entertaining programs for our community. We are in the process of planning out programs for the next few months and beyond. We will be getting back into the routine of our regular programs, plus adding new ones that we hope will be of interest.

We thank Carolyn Harrison, board member, for donating many pieces of wonderful art for a silent art auction. It was a fun and successful art auction and we appreciate Carolyn for this idea benefitting the library in distributing her art to people in our community.

Art in Action, a partnership with the Giles Arts Council, is starting a new drawing class for adults in the evenings called **Drawing Basics**. Margret Thomas will teach this class. This class will meet on the first Tuesdays of each month with the first class on January 7 at 5:30pm. There are signups for these classes as our space is limited. Our regular **Art in Action** classes for kids and adults will resume meeting on the first and fourth Wednesdays for acrylic painting with Patricia Hickman.

Art in Action: Art Show – Since our partnership with the Giles Arts Council started, we have had students of all ages participate in the art classes. In February, we will have an Art Show to display the art created during the Art in Action classes. For the attendees who have participated, the art can be dropped off during January. Please mark your calendar to come by the library during February to see the wonderful art creations. It may make you want to sign up and participate in the classes!

The month of March will bring our **Quilt Show** again! Get ready to bring your quilts for display at the library.

Also, in March we will have a series of **Genealogy Programs** on three Saturdays. Be on the lookout on our Social Media for the dates for those. If you have not done any of your own genealogy yet, this would be the perfect opportunity to learn how to get started and I promise you will be hooked!

As Spring comes on, we are partnering with Giles County UT Extension for a **"Back to the Garden" Youth Expo**. This will be for ages 8-17 and will take place on Saturday, April 26 from 9:00 – 11:00am. The topics will include container gardening, garden beds and healthy eating. Lunch will be provided, so make sure to sign up for this fun and tasty event.

Last year we started our **Seed Library**. It was very popular and we hope to continue to offer the seed library with much participation. As plants are grown, the seeds harvested, the seed library will be sustained for the next season.

All of our normal programming will resume in January. **Ask a Librarian**

happens on Wednesdays from 9:00am-12:00pm by appointment. So if you have something you need help with on your computer, phone or other device, call and make an appointment with one of our tech savvy librarians to get a little help.

Watercolor classes are happening on the fourth Tuesday of each month from 5:30-6:30pm with Caroline Bonner leading those classes. There are signups for these classes as space is limited.

Story Time is still on Fridays at 10:00am in the children's room. Miss Elizabeth and Miss T'Kayah do a wonderful job every Friday morning reading, singing and crafting with a large group of pre-school children and their parents and grandparents. Please take advantage of this opportunity for your little ones. It is a great way to get your kids active, learn to love reading and listening to stories and to meet other kids and moms in the community.

Baby & Lapsit Storytime is offered on the third Wednesday of each month and has been a great addition for our smallest patrons.

Teenagers can participate in our **Dungeons and Dragons** program on Mondays from 2:30-5:00pm. This is a growing program and if you have a sense of adventure and want to improve your strategic thinking and problem-solving skills or make some new social connections, you are welcome to come and join our group. Miss Elizabeth serves as the Dungeon Master and she does a great job with the story telling. Miss Elizabeth has also started a **Beginner Dungeons & Dragons** that happens on the last Monday of each month. This program is for ages 10-13 who have expressed an interest in learning how to play the game. Don't miss this opportunity if you want to learn to play.

Lego Club meets on the second and fourth Thursdays from 3:30 – 4:30pm for all ages.

Kids Art Club is offered on the second Wednesday of each month for ages 6-12 from 3:30-4:30pm and **STEAM Teens** stem programming is offered on the third Wednesday of each month for ages 9-16 from 3:30-4:30pm.

Our **Lynnville Branch** offers **Story Time** on the first Wednesday of each month, an **Art/Craft class** on the second Wednesday of each month and **Lego Club** on the fourth Wednesday of each month. These programs start at 10:30am for all ages.

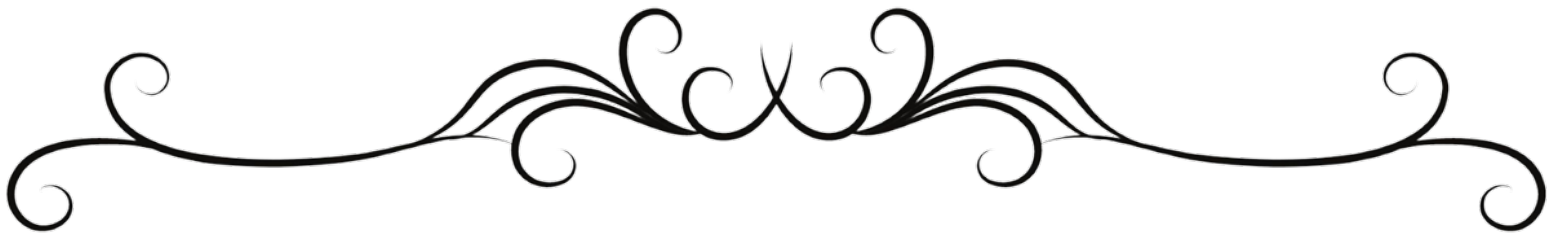
