Next week will be the last lessons of the season. All rehearsal and recital activities will be held at the Josephine Tope Auditorium attached to Nevada High School. There are no lessons May 27th – 30th.

Please read this entire packet and then if you have questions please catch Audrey between classes, stop in the office, or contact us via your preferred method. No recital meetings will be held this season.

We need help! If you would like to volunteer during one or both recitals there is a sign-up sheet in the office.

Dress Rehearsal: May 31st and/or June 1st at the Nevada High School Auditorium

- All students are **REQUIRED** to be at rehearsal. Being on stage is different than being in the studio. It is important for not only your child, but for the other students in the class to be on stage together. Please make sure to make rehearsal and recital a priority!
- ∂ Arrive 10 minutes early dressed in costume and ready to go, or arrive early enough to change there and be ready.
- ∂ Tights are not required for rehearsal.
- ∂ When you arrive please check in and then find a seat in the auditorium.
- *∂* Please keep the running around and talking to a minimum during rehearsal so you are not distracting the class on stage.
- ∂ Please do not bring extra people to dress rehearsal if possible.
- ∂ Students in grades 4th or younger must have an adult with them at rehearsal at all times
- ∂ See attached schedule for rehearsal times.

Recital: Sunday June 2nd at 1:00 PM and/or 4:00 PM at the Nevada High School Auditorium

- ∂ Arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the show dressed and ready to go, or arrive early enough to change there.
- Please take your child to the check in table at the top of the ramp by the stage door first to check in, and then your child will be escorted back stage to their seat.
- *∂* If you do go backstage with your child please only go back to get them situated and then go find your seat in the auditorium.
- ∂ Volunteers and staff members will be backstage to monitor kids.
- *∂* See attached schedule for recital placements and show order. Please pay careful attention to which show(s) your child is in.
- ∂ Doors will open 1 hour before each show.

Recital Tickets

- *∂* Your complimentary recital tickets will be made available to you once your account is paid in full for the season.
- ∂ You will receive 2 free tickets for each show that you have children in. Free tickets are per family, not per child enrolled.
- ∂ Tickets will be \$5.00 each prior to Sunday June 2nd and \$6.00 on Sunday June 2nd.
- ∂ You may purchase extra tickets anytime we are open, including while at rehearsal.
- ∂ Seating is not reserved so arrive early and together if you have a large group trying to sit together.
- ∂ You may not reserve more than just a couple seats while waiting for others to arrive.
- ∂ Anyone who will be taking up a seat needs a ticket. If a child is going to be sitting on a lap they do not need a ticket.

Recital T-shirts, CSD Clothing, Flowers, etc.

- ∂ Recital t-shirts and other studio clothing will be handed out at rehearsal.
- ϑ ~~ We have a very limited supply of extra recital shirts and CSD clothing if you want anything.
- ∂ If you did order a recital t-shirt for your child they can wear it during the recital finale.
- ∂ If you ordered flowers or either of the cups you may pick those up the day of the show in the lobby. They will not be delivered.
- ∂ Any extras we have of clothing or flowers etc. will be sold on a first come, first served basis.

Theater Etiquette

Video and Photography

- ∂ Video and photography is allowed at rehearsal, feel free to move around and get the best picture.
- ∂ ~ Photography and video is allowed at recital with restrictions:
 - You may only record your child's dance from your seat, if you are going to record the entire show you must be in the last row of the side sections.
 - If you are going to use a phone to take video or pictures please turn the screen brightness down as low as it will go so you are not disturbing guests behind you.
 - No flash will be allowed.
 - Tripods are only allowed in the last row of the side sections.
- ∂ The recital will be recorded if you wish to purchase a copy and just enjoy the show \odot
- As long as we continue to have cooperation with these rules we will continue to allow personal video and photography, however if it becomes an issue and you are interrupting the videographer or other audience members we will not allow it at future recitals.
- ∂ You will be able to use the stage after the rehearsal and recital for pictures as well.

Backstage Access

- Once the show has started there will be no entrance backstage allowed. Volunteers and staff members will be the only ones allowed backstage during the show. This has been a problem the last couple of years and it is frustrating that those volunteering their time to take care of the kids are having to deal with this, please trust us to ensure your child gets changed and where they need to go or you may volunteer backstage yourself.
- ∂ This is not only for the safety of the kids backstage, but it is a distraction to those backstage as well as the audience.
- ∂ Kids will not be coming out to the audience. They will stay backstage for the entire show.
- No males may come backstage. The way the dressing rooms are set up does not allow us to have males backstage. All boys that are dancing in the show will have their own room with a door.
- A staff member will be right inside the stage door and will turn you away if you try to come backstage, unless you have an emergency in which you need to take your child or you have been paged to come backstage.
- We run a highly organized backstage. We promise your child will be taken care of, they will get their costume changed in time, hair pieces changed out, shoes changed, etc. and where they need to be.
- Our shows are less than 2 hours long. We have movies, activities, and snacks to keep them entertained. We keep them busy so the show goes by quickly for them.
- ∂ As always if your child needs you we will page you to come backstage.
- ∂ Please just enjoy the show and leave the worrying to us!

General Etiquette

- ∂ Remain seated for entire numbers.
 - \circ $\;$ If you need to get up please wait until the song has ended and the class is off stage.
 - o This ensures you are not blocking someone's view or messing up the videographers recording.
- ∂ Shut off or silence your phones so they don't ring during the show and please stay off of them during the show.
- No food or drink is allowed in the auditorium. If you purchased either of the cups with candy please be sure your child waits to eat any of it until they are in the lobby or have left the building.
- I know there will be kids in the audience. If you need to bring things to entertain them please make sure those items do not make noise or have a screen that is going to be on for the entire show. Again, think of those around you.
- Be supportive! The kids love to hear applause. It makes them happy, gets them excited, and helps calm nerves. It really adds to their on stage experience.
- Be kind and considerate! Think of those around you. Think if what you are doing would upset you if the person in front of you were doing it (like blocking someone's view with a camera or getting up in the middle of a number etc.)

Costuming Requirements

Tights

- ∂ Capezio brand light suntan color tights are required for all girls whose costumes are not full-length pants.
- ∂ Classes whose costumes are full-length pants are excused from wearing tights, although still suggested.
- ∂ Boys do not need tights, but for those with black pants for their outfit we suggest wearing black socks.
- ∂ We do have tights available at the studio if you need them.

Shoes

- ∂ Correct style/color shoes are required for everyone.
- ∂ If you need shoes we have both used and new available at the studio.
- **∂** Class requirements are listed below:
 - Tap classes Black tap shoes
 - o Ballet classes Pink leather or canvas ballets (Boys need black)
 - Jazz/Hip Hop/Lyrical/Pom classes Tan jazz shoes
 - Tumbling classes White Acro shoes
- ∂ If you need shoes or tights please take care of this during the last weeks of class.
 - We will have tights at the auditorium available to purchase in case someone needs them, but we will not have shoes.

Costumes

- ∂ Please make sure you have all parts of your costume use the checklist!
- **∂** Put your child's name in all parts of their costume!

Hair and Make-up

- ∂ You may style hair however you want; all we ask is that it is out of their face.
- ∂ The hair accessories that come with the costume are optional, with the exception of hats for K-1st Grade Jazz/Hip Hop
- When doing your child's hair keep in mind what dances they are in (don't style hair on top of the head for tumbling or classes with hats for example.)
- ∂ Make-up is not required.
- ∂ Heavy make-up is always discouraged, go for the enhanced natural look \odot

Jewelry

 ∂ No jewelry other than stud earrings is allowed.

Undergarments

- ∂ Please be aware of the color of undergarments your child wears.
- ∂ Make sure they are a nude color.
- If your child will be wearing a bra please be sure it is either nude or matches the costume or that the straps are clear and that no part of it can be seen. I understand that might be difficult on some costumes, but what we are really trying to avoid is a lot of straps showing on an open back costume.
- O Usually we suggest no underwear with tights, but we know some people are not comfortable with that so please just make sure they are a neutral color and make sure they can't be seen under the costume.

End Of The Season Reminders

No Classes: There will be no classes held May 27th – 30th so the studio can prepare for recital weekend. We will not be in the studio on a regular basis after Thursday of next week (May 23rd). If you need something just call, text, e-mail, or Facebook us and we will get back to you as soon as we can.

Tuition Payments: The final tuition payment is due June 1st. Tuition is billed in 9 payments starting in October and ending in June. We bill a month behind. June tuition has been applied to accounts already, but it is not due until June 1st. Auto-pay will run like normal for the month of June.

As stated under the ticket info, no free tickets will be released to you until your account is paid in full.

We will accept checks for no more than 2 months tuition. Any amount above that must be paid for in cash, card, or PayPal.

Watch Week: The final watch week is May $20^{th} - 23^{rd}$. You may stay and observe classes this week.

Pictures: You may pick up your pictures during the last week of classes. Pictures will be sent home with kids if no parent comes in. If you believe there is an error in your order please contact the photographer at seeleyphoto@hotmail.com






