SPIRIT DAY



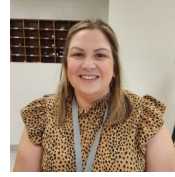
On the last Friday of the month, student can show their school spirit by wearing ANY Maurepas school shirt with appropriate blue jeans.

Mrs. Krystan is the 3rd and 4th grade teacher.



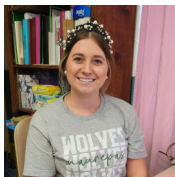
Mrs. Madison Vige

Mrs. Williams is the school counselor secretary.



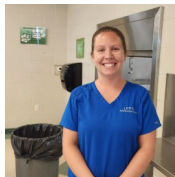

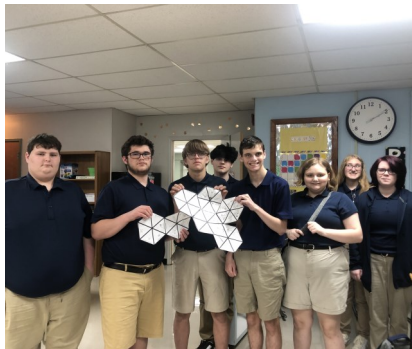
