

## SHIRLEY ANN CUNNINGHAM 1936 - 1995

Shirley A. Cunningham, 59, co-cemer of Ron's Party Store in Elition, died Sunday afternoon, Nov. 12 at her home, following a long battle with cancer.

She was born April 27, 1936 in Detroit, to Lucille (Smith) Murphy and the late James Murphy. On Nov. 8, 1958 she was united in marriage to Ronald B. Cunningham in Detroit. In 1970, they moved to Elkion. Three years later, they bought Rex's Store on Main Street, renaming it Ron's Party Store.
