ITALIAN COURSES:

INTRODUCTION TO ITALIAN

8-week session - \$100

Wednesday 5:00pm - 6:00pm

Instructor: Daniela Ciccone

This is an introductory course designed for people who have no prior knowledge of Italian.

Topics will include: pronunciation, greetings, days, dates, numbers, time, expressing personal information and an introduction to basic grammar concepts.

This course does not require a textbook.

ITALIAN BEGINNER 1

8-week session - \$100

Topics will include: food vocabulary, dialogues and expressions related to food/eating out, an introduction to present tense verbs in order to facilitate conversation.
